15	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
16	That §21-14-3 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
17	be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
18	ARTICLE 14. SUPERVISION OF PLUMBING WORK.
19	<pre>§21-14-3. License required; exemptions.</pre>
20	(a) On and after January 1, 2009, a person performing or
21	offering to perform plumbing work in this state shall <u>must</u> have a
22	license issued by the Commissioner of Labor, in accordance with the
23	provisions of this article.

(b) A person licensed under this article must carry a copy of
 the license on any job in which plumbing work is being performed.
 (c) This article does not apply to:

4 (1) A person who personally performs plumbing work on a single 5 family dwelling owned or leased by that person or by a member of 6 that person's immediate family;

7 (2) A person who performs plumbing at any manufacturing plant
8 or other industrial establishment as an employee of the person,
9 firm or corporation operating the plant or establishment;

10 (3) A person who performs plumbing work while employed by an 11 employer who engages in the business of selling appliances at 12 retail, so long as such the plumbing work is performed incidental 13 to the installation or repair of appliances sold by the employer; 14 (4) A person who, while employed by a public utility or its 15 affiliate, performs plumbing in connection with the furnishing of 16 public utility service;

17 (5) A person who performs plumbing work while engaging in the 18 business of installing, altering or repairing water distribution or 19 drainage lines outside the foundation walls of a building, public 20 or private sewage treatment or water treatment systems including 21 all associated structures or buildings, sewers or underground 22 utility services;

(6) A person who performs plumbing work while engaged in the24 installation, extension, dismantling, adjustment, repair, servicing

1 or alteration of a heating ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC)
2 system, air-veyor system, air exhaust system or air handling
3 system;

4 (7) A person who performs plumbing work at a coal mine that is 5 being actively mined or where coal is being processed; or

6 (8) A person who performs plumbing work at manufacturing,7 industrial and natural gas facilities; or

8 (9) A person employed by a county board of education who 9 performs plumbing work on board of education property.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to exempt individuals employed by a county board of education from plumbing licensing requirements while performing plumbing work on board of education property.
