Additional duties of limited video lottery retailers. 19 In addition to the general duties imposed on all licensees in 20 section 22B-701 seven hundred one of this article, a limited video 21 lottery retailer shall: (1) Attend all commission mandated meetings, seminars and 22 23 training sessions concerning operation of video lottery terminals,

- 1 the validation and redemption of video lottery winning tickets and
- 2 the operation of all ticket validation terminals and equipment;
- 3 (2) Maintain all skills necessary for the accurate validation 4 of video lottery tickets;
- 5 (3) Supervise video lottery operations and ticket validation 6 procedures at the applicable location;
- 7 (4) Permit no person to tamper with or interfere with the 8 operation of any video lottery terminal;
- 9 (5) Ensure that telephone lines from the commission's central 10 control computer to the video lottery terminals located at the 11 approved location are at all times connected, and prevent any 12 person from tampering or interfering with the operation of the 13 telephone lines;
- 14 (6) Ensure that video lottery terminals are within the sight
 15 and control of designated employees of the limited video lottery
 16 retailer;
- 17 (7) Ensure that video lottery terminals are placed and remain 18 placed in the specific locations which have been approved by the 19 commission. A video lottery terminal in a restricted access 20 adult-only facility may not be relocated within the facility 21 without the prior written approval of the commission;
- (8) Monitor video lottery terminals to prevent access to or 23 play by persons who are under the age of twenty-one years or who 24 are visibly intoxicated;

- 1 (9) Maintain at all times sufficient change and cash in the 2 denominations accepted by the video lottery terminals;
- 3 (10) Provide no access by a player to an automated teller
 4 machine (ATM) in the restricted access adult-only facility where
 5 video lottery games are played, accept no credit card or debit card
 6 from a player for the exchange or purchase of video lottery game
 7 credits or for an advance of coins or currency to be utilized by a
 8 player to play video lottery games and extend no credit, in any
 9 manner, to a player so as to enable the player to play a video
 10 lottery game;
- 11 (11) Pay for all credits won upon presentment of a valid 12 winning video lottery ticket;
- 13 (12) Report promptly in writing to the operator and the
 14 commission all video lottery terminal malfunctions and notify the
 15 commission in writing of the failure of an operator or service
 16 technician to provide prompt service and repair of the terminals
 17 and associated equipment;
- 18 (13) Conduct no video lottery advertising or promotional
 19 activities;
- 20 (14) Not use the words "video lottery" in the name of the 21 approved location, or in any directions or advertising visible from
- 22 outside the retailer's establishment;
- 23 (15) (13) Install, post and display prominently within or 24 about the approved location signs, redemption information and other

- 1 promotional material as required by the commission;
- 2 (16) (14) Permit video lottery to be played only during those
- 3 hours established and approved by the commission: Provided, That
- 4 the limited video lottery retailer shall may not permit video
- 5 lottery to be played beyond the hour during which liquor may be
- 6 served;
- 7 $\frac{(17)}{(15)}$ (15) Contract with no more than one licensed operator for
- 8 the placement of video lottery terminals at the licensed location;
- 9 (18) (16) Maintain insurance covering all losses as the result
- 10 of fire, theft or vandalism to video lottery terminals and
- 11 associated equipment; and
- (19) (17) Comply with all applicable provisions of this
- 13 article and rules and orders of the commission.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to remove the limitations on advertising and promotional activities by limited video lottery retailers.
