10 A BILL to amend and reenact §17A-3-14 of the Code of West Virginia,
11 1931, as amended, relating to providing discounted motor
12 vehicle registration fees for members of volunteer fire
13 departments.

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

15 That §17A-3-14 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
16 be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

17 **ARTICLE 3. ORIGINAL AND RENEWAL OF REGISTRATION; ISSUANCE OF**
18 **CERTIFICATES OF TITLE.**

19 **§17A-3-14. Registration plates generally; description of plates;**
20 **issuance of special numbers and plates; registration**
21 **fees; special application fees; exemptions;**
22 **commissioner to promulgate forms; suspension and**
23 **nonrenewal.**

24 (a) The division upon registering a vehicle shall issue to the

1 owner one registration plate for a motorcycle, trailer, semitrailer
2 or other motor vehicle.

3 (b) Registration plates issued by the division shall meet the
4 following requirements:

5 (1) Every registration plate shall be of reflectorized
6 material and have displayed upon it the registration number
7 assigned to the vehicle for which it is issued; the name of this
8 state, which may be abbreviated; and the year number for which it
9 is issued or the date of expiration of the plate.

10 (2) Every registration plate and the required letters and
11 numerals on the plate shall be of sufficient size to be plainly
12 readable from a distance of one hundred feet during daylight:
13 *Provided*, That the requirements of this subdivision shall not apply
14 to the year number for which the plate is issued or the date of
15 expiration.

16 (3) Registration numbering for registration plates shall begin
17 with number two.

18 (c) The division may not issue, permit to be issued or
19 distribute any special registration plates except as follows:

20 (1) The Governor shall be issued two registration plates, on
21 one of which shall be imprinted the numeral one and on the other
22 the word one.

23 (2) State officials and judges may be issued special
24 registration plates as follows:

1 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue to
2 the Secretary of State, State Superintendent of Schools, Auditor,
3 Treasurer, Commissioner of Agriculture and the Attorney General,
4 the members of both houses of the Legislature, including the
5 elected officials of both houses of the Legislature, the justices
6 of the Supreme Court of Appeals of West Virginia, the
7 representatives and senators of the state in the Congress of the
8 United States, the judges of the West Virginia circuit courts,
9 active and retired on senior status, the judges of the United
10 States district courts for the State of West Virginia and the
11 judges of the United States Court of Appeals for the fourth
12 circuit, if any of the judges are residents of West Virginia, a
13 special registration plate for a Class A motor vehicle and a
14 special registration plate for a Class G motorcycle owned by the
15 official or his or her spouse: *Provided*, That the division may
16 issue a Class A special registration plate for each vehicle titled
17 to the official and a Class G special registration plate for each
18 motorcycle titled to the official.

19 (B) Each plate issued pursuant to this subdivision shall bear
20 any combination of letters and numbers not to exceed an amount
21 determined by the commissioner and a designation of the office.
22 Each plate shall supersede the regular numbered plate assigned to
23 the official or his or her spouse during the official's term of
24 office and while the motor vehicle is owned by the official or his

1 or her spouse.

2 (C) The division shall charge an annual fee of \$15 for every
3 registration plate issued pursuant to this subdivision, which is in
4 addition to all other fees required by this chapter.

5 (3) The division may issue members of the National Guard
6 forces special registration plates as follows:

7 (A) Upon receipt of an application on a form prescribed by the
8 division and receipt of written evidence from the chief executive
9 officer of the Army National Guard or Air National Guard, as
10 appropriate, or the commanding officer of any United States Armed
11 Forces reserve unit that the applicant is a member thereof, the
12 division shall issue to any member of the National Guard of this
13 state or a member of any reserve unit of the United States Armed
14 Forces a special registration plate designed by the commissioner
15 for any number of Class A motor vehicles owned by the member. Upon
16 presentation of written evidence of retirement status, retired
17 members of this state's Army or Air National Guard, or retired
18 members of any reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces, are
19 eligible to purchase the special registration plate issued pursuant
20 to this subdivision.

21 (B) The division shall charge an initial application fee of
22 \$10 for each special registration plate issued pursuant to this
23 subdivision, which is in addition to all other fees required by
24 this chapter. Except as otherwise provided herein, effective July

1 1, 2007, all fees currently held in the special revolving fund used
2 in the administration of this section and all fees collected by the
3 division shall be deposited in the State Road Fund.

4 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased
5 spouse's National Guard forces license plate until the surviving
6 spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the license plate.

7 (4) Specially arranged registration plates may be issued as
8 follows:

9 (A) Upon appropriate application, any owner of a motor vehicle
10 subject to Class A registration, or a motorcycle subject to Class
11 G registration, as defined by this article, may request that the
12 division issue a registration plate bearing specially arranged
13 letters or numbers with the maximum number of letters or numbers to
14 be determined by the commissioner. The division shall attempt to
15 comply with the request wherever possible.

16 (B) The commissioner shall propose rules for legislative
17 approval in accordance with the provisions of chapter twenty-nine-a
18 of this code regarding the orderly distribution of the plates:
19 *Provided*, That for purposes of this subdivision, the registration
20 plates requested and issued shall include all plates bearing the
21 numbers two through two thousand.

22 (C) An annual fee of \$15 shall be charged for each special
23 registration plate issued pursuant to this subdivision, which is in
24 addition to all other fees required by this chapter.

1 (5) The division may issue honorably discharged veterans
2 special registration plates as follows:

3 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue to
4 any honorably discharged veteran of any branch of the armed
5 services of the United States a special registration plate for any
6 number of vehicles titled in the name of the qualified applicant
7 with an insignia designed by the Commissioner of the Division of
8 Motor Vehicles.

9 (B) The division shall charge a special initial application
10 fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by law. This
11 special fee is to compensate the Division of Motor Vehicles for
12 additional costs and services required in the issuing of the
13 special registration. All fees collected by the division shall be
14 deposited in the State Road Fund: *Provided*, That nothing in this
15 section may be construed to exempt any veteran from any other
16 provision of this chapter.

17 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased
18 spouse's honorably discharged veterans license plate until the
19 surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the license
20 plate.

21 (6) The division may issue disabled veterans special
22 registration plates as follows:

23 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue to
24 any disabled veteran who is exempt from the payment of registration

1 fees under the provisions of this chapter a registration plate for
2 a vehicle titled in the name of the qualified applicant which bears
3 the letters "DV" in red and also the regular identification
4 numerals in red.

5 (B) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased
6 spouse's disabled veterans license plate until the surviving spouse
7 dies, remarries or does not renew the license plate.

8 (C) A qualified disabled veteran may obtain a second disabled
9 veterans license plate as described in this section for use on a
10 passenger vehicle titled in the name of the qualified applicant.
11 The division shall charge a one-time fee of \$10 to be deposited
12 into the State Road Fund, in addition to all other fees required by
13 this chapter, for the second plate.

14 (7) The division may issue recipients of the distinguished
15 Purple Heart medal special registration plates as follows:

16 (A) Upon appropriate application, there shall be issued to any
17 armed service person holding the distinguished Purple Heart medal
18 for persons wounded in combat a registration plate for a vehicle
19 titled in the name of the qualified applicant bearing letters or
20 numbers. The registration plate shall be designed by the
21 Commissioner of Motor Vehicles and shall denote that those
22 individuals who are granted this special registration plate are
23 recipients of the Purple Heart. All letterings shall be in purple
24 where practical.

1 (B) Registration plates issued pursuant to this subdivision
2 are exempt from all registration fees otherwise required by the
3 provisions of this chapter.

4 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased
5 spouse's Purple Heart medal license plate until the surviving
6 spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the license plate.

7 (D) A recipient of the Purple Heart medal may obtain a second
8 Purple Heart medal license plate as described in this section for
9 use on a passenger vehicle titled in the name of the qualified
10 applicant. The division shall charge a one-time fee of \$10 to be
11 deposited into the State Road Fund, in addition to all other fees
12 required by this chapter, for the second plate.

13 (8) The division may issue survivors of the attack on Pearl
14 Harbor special registration plates as follows:

15 (A) Upon appropriate application, the owner of a motor vehicle
16 who was enlisted in any branch of the armed services that
17 participated in and survived the attack on Pearl Harbor on December
18 7, 1941, the division shall issue a special registration plate for
19 a vehicle titled in the name of the qualified applicant. The
20 registration plate shall be designed by the Commissioner of Motor
21 Vehicles.

22 (B) Registration plates issued pursuant to this subdivision
23 are exempt from the payment of all registration fees otherwise
24 required by the provisions of this chapter.

1 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased
2 spouse's survivors of the attack on Pearl Harbor license plate
3 until the surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the
4 license plate.

5 (D) A survivor of the attack on Pearl Harbor may obtain a
6 second survivors of the attack on Pearl Harbor license plate as
7 described in this section for use on a passenger vehicle titled in
8 the name of the qualified applicant. The division shall charge a
9 one-time fee of \$10 to be deposited into the State Road Fund, in
10 addition to all other fees required by this chapter, for the second
11 plate.

12 (9) The division may issue special registration plates to
13 nonprofit charitable and educational organizations authorized under
14 prior enactment of this subdivision as follows:

15 (A) Approved nonprofit charitable and educational
16 organizations previously authorized under the prior enactment of
17 this subdivision may accept and collect applications for special
18 registration plates from owners of Class A motor vehicles together
19 with a special annual fee of \$15, which is in addition to all other
20 fees required by this chapter. The applications and fees shall be
21 submitted to the Division of Motor Vehicles with the request that
22 the division issue a registration plate bearing a combination of
23 letters or numbers with the organizations' logo or emblem, with the
24 maximum number of letters or numbers to be determined by the

1 commissioner.

2 (B) The commissioner shall propose rules for legislative
3 approval in accordance with the provisions of article three,
4 chapter twenty-nine-a of this code regarding the procedures for and
5 approval of special registration plates issued pursuant to this
6 subdivision.

7 (C) The commissioner shall set an appropriate fee to defray
8 the administrative costs associated with designing and
9 manufacturing special registration plates for a nonprofit
10 charitable or educational organization. The nonprofit charitable or
11 educational organization shall collect this fee and forward it to
12 the division for deposit in the State Road Fund. The nonprofit
13 charitable or educational organization may also collect a fee for
14 marketing the special registration plates.

15 (10) The division may issue specified emergency or volunteer
16 registration plates as follows:

17 (A) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a resident of the
18 State of West Virginia and who is a certified paramedic or
19 emergency medical technician, a member of a paid fire department,
20 a member of the state Fire Commission, the State Fire Marshal, the
21 State Fire Marshal's assistants, the State Fire Administrator and
22 voluntary rescue squad members may apply for a special license
23 plate for any number of Class A vehicles titled in the name of the
24 qualified applicant which bears the insignia of the profession,

1 group or commission. Any insignia shall be designed by the
2 commissioner. License plates issued pursuant to this subdivision
3 shall bear the requested insignia in addition to the registration
4 number issued to the applicant pursuant to the provisions of this
5 article.

6 (B) Each application submitted pursuant to this subdivision
7 shall be accompanied by an affidavit signed by the fire chief or
8 department head of the applicant stating that the applicant is
9 justified in having a registration with the requested insignia;
10 proof of compliance with all laws of this state regarding
11 registration and licensure of motor vehicles; and payment of all
12 required fees.

13 (C) Each application submitted pursuant to this subdivision
14 shall be accompanied by payment of a special initial application
15 fee of \$10, which is in addition to any other registration or
16 license fee required by this chapter. All special fees shall be
17 collected by the division and deposited into the state Road Fund.

18 (11) The division may issue specified certified firefighter
19 registration plates as follows:

20 (A) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a resident of the
21 State of West Virginia and who is a certified firefighter may apply
22 for a special license plate which bears the insignia of the
23 profession, for any number of Class A vehicles titled in the name
24 of the qualified applicant. Any insignia shall be designed by the

1 commissioner. License plates issued pursuant to this subdivision
2 shall bear the requested insignia pursuant to the provisions of
3 this article. Upon presentation of written evidence of
4 certification as a certified firefighter, certified firefighters
5 are eligible to purchase the special registration plate issued
6 pursuant to this subdivision.

7 (B) Each application submitted pursuant to this subdivision
8 shall be accompanied by an affidavit stating that the applicant is
9 justified in having a registration with the requested insignia;
10 proof of compliance with all laws of this state regarding
11 registration and licensure of motor vehicles; and payment of all
12 required fees. The firefighter certification department, section or
13 division of the West Virginia University fire service extension
14 shall notify the commissioner in writing immediately when a
15 firefighter loses his or her certification. If a firefighter loses
16 his or her certification, the commissioner may not issue him or her
17 a license plate under this subsection.

18 (C) Each application submitted pursuant to this subdivision
19 shall be accompanied by payment of a special initial application
20 fee of \$10, which is in addition to any other registration or
21 license fee required by this chapter. All special fees shall be
22 collected by the division and deposited into the State Road Fund.

23 (12) The division may issue special scenic registration plates
24 as follows:

1 (A) Upon appropriate application, the commissioner shall issue
2 a special registration plate displaying a scenic design of West
3 Virginia which displays the words "Wild Wonderful" as a slogan.

4 (B) The division shall charge a special one-time initial
5 application fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by
6 this chapter. All initial application fees collected by the
7 division shall be deposited into the State Road Fund.

8 (13) The division may issue honorably discharged Marine Corps
9 league members special registration plates as follows:

10 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue to
11 any honorably discharged Marine Corps league member a special
12 registration plate for any number of vehicles titled in the name of
13 the qualified applicant with an insignia designed by the
14 Commissioner of the Division of Motor Vehicles.

15 (B) The division may charge a special one-time initial
16 application fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by
17 this chapter. This special fee is to compensate the Division of
18 Motor Vehicles for additional costs and services required in the
19 issuing of the special registration and shall be collected by the
20 division and deposited in the State Road Fund: *Provided*, That
21 nothing in this section may be construed to exempt any veteran from
22 any other provision of this chapter.

23 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased
24 spouse's honorably discharged Marine Corps League license plate

1 until the surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the
2 license plate.

3 (14) The division may issue military organization registration
4 plates as follows:

5 (A) The division may issue a special registration plate for
6 the members of any military organization chartered by the United
7 States Congress upon receipt of a guarantee from the organization
8 of a minimum of one hundred applicants. The insignia on the plate
9 shall be designed by the commissioner.

10 (B) Upon appropriate application, the division may issue
11 members of the chartered organization in good standing, as
12 determined by the governing body of the chartered organization, a
13 special registration plate for any number of vehicles titled in the
14 name of the qualified applicant.

15 (C) The division shall charge a special one-time initial
16 application fee of \$10 for each special license plate in addition
17 to all other fees required by this chapter. All initial application
18 fees collected by the division shall be deposited into the State
19 Road Fund: *Provided*, That nothing in this section may be construed
20 to exempt any veteran from any other provision of this chapter.

21 (D) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased
22 spouse's military organization registration plate until the
23 surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the special
24 military organization registration plate.

1 (15) The division may issue special nongame wildlife
2 registration plates and special wildlife registration plates as
3 follows:

4 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue a
5 special registration plate displaying a species of West Virginia
6 wildlife which shall display a species of wildlife native to West
7 Virginia as prescribed and designated by the commissioner and the
8 Director of the Division of Natural Resources.

9 (B) The division shall charge an annual fee of \$15 for each
10 special nongame wildlife registration plate and each special
11 wildlife registration plate in addition to all other fees required
12 by this chapter. All annual fees collected for nongame wildlife
13 registration plates and wildlife registration plates shall be
14 deposited in a special revenue account designated the Nongame
15 Wildlife Fund and credited to the Division of Natural Resources.

16 (C) The division shall charge a special one-time initial
17 application fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by
18 this chapter. All initial application fees collected by the
19 division shall be deposited in the State Road Fund.

20 (16) The division may issue members of the Silver Haired
21 Legislature special registration plates as follows:

22 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue to
23 any person who is a duly qualified member of the Silver Haired
24 Legislature a specialized registration plate which bears

1 recognition of the applicant as a member of the Silver Haired
2 Legislature.

3 (B) A qualified member of the Silver Haired Legislature may
4 obtain one registration plate described in this subdivision for use
5 on a passenger vehicle titled in the name of the qualified
6 applicant. The division shall charge an annual fee of \$15, in
7 addition to all other fees required by this chapter, for the plate.
8 All annual fees collected by the division shall be deposited in the
9 State Road Fund.

10 (17) Upon appropriate application, the commissioner shall
11 issue to a classic motor vehicle or classic motorcycle as defined
12 in section three-a, article ten of this chapter, a special
13 registration plate designed by the commissioner. An annual fee of
14 \$15, in addition to all other fees required by this chapter, shall
15 be charged for each classic registration plate.

16 (18) Honorably discharged veterans may be issued special
17 registration plates for motorcycles subject to Class G registration
18 as follows:

19 (A) Upon appropriate application, there shall be issued to any
20 honorably discharged veteran of any branch of the armed services of
21 the United States a special registration plate for any number of
22 motorcycles subject to Class G registration titled in the name of
23 the qualified applicant with an insignia designed by the
24 Commissioner of the Division of Motor Vehicles.

1 (B) A special initial application fee of \$10 shall be charged
2 in addition to all other fees required by law. This special fee is
3 to be collected by the division and deposited in the State Road
4 Fund: *Provided*, That nothing in this section may be construed to
5 exempt any veteran from any other provision of this chapter.

6 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased
7 spouse's honorably discharged veterans license plate until the
8 surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the license
9 plate.

10 (19) Racing theme special registration plates:

11 (A) The division may issue a series of special registration
12 plates displaying National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing
13 themes.

14 (B) An annual fee of \$25 shall be charged for each special
15 racing theme registration plate in addition to all other fees
16 required by this chapter. All annual fees collected for each
17 special racing theme registration plate shall be deposited into the
18 State Road Fund.

19 (C) A special application fee of \$10 shall be charged at the
20 time of initial application as well as upon application for any
21 duplicate or replacement registration plate, in addition to all
22 other fees required by this chapter. All application fees shall be
23 deposited into the State Road Fund.

24 (20) The division may issue recipients of the Navy Cross,

1 Distinguished Service Cross, Distinguished Flying Cross, Air Force
2 Cross, Bronze Star, Silver Star or Air Medal special registration
3 plates as follows:

4 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue to
5 any recipient of the Navy Cross, Distinguished Service Cross,
6 Distinguished Flying Cross, Air Force Cross, Silver Star, Bronze
7 Star or Air Medal, a registration plate for any number of vehicles
8 titled in the name of the qualified applicant bearing letters or
9 numbers. A separate registration plate shall be designed by the
10 Commissioner of Motor Vehicles for each award that denotes that
11 those individuals who are granted this special registration plate
12 are recipients of the Navy Cross, Distinguished Service Cross,
13 Distinguished Flying Cross, Air Force Cross, Silver Star or Bronze
14 Star, or Air Medal as applicable.

15 (B) The division shall charge a special initial application
16 fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by law. This
17 special fee shall be collected by the division and deposited in the
18 State Road Fund: *Provided*, That nothing in this section exempts the
19 applicant for a special registration plate under this subdivision
20 from any other provision of this chapter.

21 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased
22 spouse's Navy Cross, Distinguished Service Cross, Distinguished
23 Flying Cross, Air Force Cross, Silver Star, Bronze Star or Air
24 Medal special registration plate until the surviving spouse dies,

1 remarries or does not renew the special registration plate.

2 (21) The division may issue honorably discharged veterans
3 special registration plates as follows:

4 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue to
5 any honorably discharged veteran of any branch of the armed
6 services of the United States with verifiable service during World
7 War II, the Korean War, the Vietnam War, the Persian Gulf War or
8 the War Against Terrorism a special registration plate for any
9 number of vehicles titled in the name of the qualified applicant
10 with an insignia designed by the commissioner denoting service in
11 the applicable conflict.

12 (B) The division shall charge a special one-time initial
13 application fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by
14 law. This special fee shall be collected by the division and
15 deposited in the State Road Fund: *Provided*, That nothing contained
16 in this section may be construed to exempt any veteran from any
17 other provision of this chapter.

18 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased
19 spouse's honorably discharged veterans registration plate until the
20 surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the special
21 registration plate.

22 (22) The division may issue special volunteer firefighter
23 registration plates as follows:

24 (A) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a resident of West

1 Virginia and who is a volunteer firefighter may apply for a special
2 license plate for any Class A vehicle titled in the name of the
3 qualified applicant which bears the insignia of the profession in
4 white letters on a red background. The insignia shall be designed
5 by the commissioner and shall contain a fireman's helmet insignia
6 on the left side of the license plate.

7 (B) Each application submitted pursuant to this subdivision
8 shall be accompanied by an affidavit signed by the applicant's fire
9 chief, stating that the applicant is a volunteer firefighter and
10 justified in having a registration plate with the requested
11 insignia. The applicant must comply with all other laws of this
12 state regarding registration and licensure of motor vehicles and
13 must pay all required fees.

14 (C) Each application submitted pursuant to this subdivision
15 shall be accompanied by payment of a special one-time initial
16 application fee of \$10, which is in addition to any other
17 registration or license fee required by this chapter. Any member of
18 a volunteer fire department, whether purchasing a special
19 registration plate pursuant to this section or purchasing a
20 standard issue registration plate, shall receive two years' motor
21 vehicle registration upon payment of a one-year registration fee.
22 A member of a volunteer fire department must provide documentation
23 of volunteer fire department membership as set forth in this
24 section to receive the discounted registration fee every two years.

1 All application fees shall be deposited into the State Road Fund.

2 (23) The division may issue special registration plates which
3 reflect patriotic themes, including the display of any United
4 States symbol, icon, phrase or expression which evokes patriotic
5 pride or recognition.

6 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue to
7 an applicant a registration plate of the applicant's choice,
8 displaying a patriotic theme as provided in this subdivision, for
9 a vehicle titled in the name of the applicant. A series of
10 registration plates displaying patriotic themes shall be designed
11 by the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles for distribution to
12 applicants.

13 (B) The division shall charge a special one-time initial
14 application fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by
15 law. This special fee shall be collected by the division and
16 deposited in the State Road Fund.

17 (24) Special license plates bearing the American flag and the
18 logo "9/11/01".

19 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue
20 special registration plates which shall display the American flag
21 and the logo "9/11/01".

22 (B) An annual fee of \$15 shall be charged for each plate in
23 addition to all other fees required by this chapter.

24 (C) A special application fee of \$10 shall be charged at the

1 time of initial application as well as upon application for any
2 duplicate or replacement registration plate, in addition to all
3 other fees required by this chapter. All application fees shall be
4 deposited into the State Road Fund.

5 (25) The division may issue a special registration plate
6 celebrating the centennial of the 4-H youth development movement
7 and honoring the Future Farmers of America organization as follows:

8 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division may issue a
9 special registration plate depicting the symbol of the 4-H
10 organization which represents the head, heart, hands and health as
11 well as the symbol of the Future Farmers of America organization
12 which represents a cross section of an ear of corn for any number

1 special registration plate designed by the commissioner for any
2 number of vehicles titled in the name of the qualified applicant.

3 (B) The division shall charge a special initial application
4 fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by law. This
5 special fee shall be collected by the division and deposited in the
6 State Road Fund.

7 (C) The division shall charge an annual fee of \$15 for each
8 special educator registration plate in addition to all other fees
9 required by this chapter.

10 (27) The division may issue special registration plates to
11 members of the Nemesis Shrine as follows:

12 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division may issue a
13 special registration plate designed by the commissioner for any
14 number of vehicles titled in the name of the qualified applicant.
15 Persons desiring the special registration plate shall offer
16 sufficient proof of membership in Nemesis Shrine.

17 (B) The division shall charge a special initial application
18 fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by law. This
19 special fee shall be collected by the division and deposited in the
20 State Road Fund.

21 (C) An annual fee of \$15 shall be charged for each plate in
22 addition to all other fees required by this chapter.

23 (D) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (d) of this
24 section, the time period for the Nemesis Shrine to comply with the

1 minimum one hundred prepaid applications is hereby extended to
2 January 15, 2005.

3 (28) The division may issue volunteers and employees of the
4 American Red Cross special registration plates as follows:

5 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue to
6 any person who is a duly qualified volunteer or employee of the
7 American Red Cross a specialized registration plate which bears
8 recognition of the applicant as a volunteer or employee of the
9 American Red Cross for any number of vehicles titled in the name of
10 the qualified applicant.

11 (B) The division shall charge a special initial application
12 fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by law. This
13 special fee shall be collected by the division and deposited in the
14 State Road Fund.

15 (C) An annual fee of \$15 shall be charged for each plate in
16 addition to all other fees required by this chapter.

17 (29) The division shall issue special registration plates to

20 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue a

2 (B) The division shall charge a special initial application

5 State Road Fund.

6 (30) The division may issue special registration plates to
7 members of the Knights of Columbus as follows:

8 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue a
9 special registration plate designed by the commissioner for any
10 number of vehicles titled in the name of the qualified applicant.
11 Persons desiring the special registration plate shall offer
12 sufficient proof of membership in the Knights of Columbus.

13 (B) The division shall charge a special initial application
14 fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by law. This
15 special fee shall be collected by the division and deposited in the
16 State Road Fund.

17 (C) An annual fee of \$15 shall be charged for each plate in
18 addition to all other fees required by this chapter.

19 (D) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (d) of this
20 section, the time period for the Knights of Columbus to comply with
21 the minimum one hundred prepaid applications is hereby extended to
22 January 15, 2007.

23 (31) The division may issue special registration plates to
24 former members of the Legislature as follows:

1 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue a
2 special registration plate designed by the commissioner for any
3 number of vehicles titled in the name of the qualified applicant.
4 Persons desiring the special registration plate shall offer
5 sufficient proof of former service as an elected or appointed
6 member of the West Virginia House of Delegates or the West Virginia
7 Senate.

8 (B) The division shall charge a special initial application
9 fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by law. This
10 special fee shall be collected by the division and deposited in the
11 State Road Fund. The design of the plate shall indicate total years

1 (B) A special initial application fee of \$10 shall be charged
2 in addition to all other fees required by law. This special fee
3 shall be collected by the division and deposited in the State Road
4 Fund: *Provided*, That nothing in this section may be construed to
5 exempt any veteran from any other provision of this chapter.

6 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his deceased
7 spouse's honorably discharged veterans license plate until the
8 surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the license
9 plate.

10 (34) The division may issue special registration plates
11 bearing the logo, symbol, insignia, letters or words demonstrating
12 association with West Liberty State College to any resident owner
13 of a motor vehicle. Resident owners may apply for the special
14 license plate for any number of Class A vehicles titled in the name
15 of the applicant. The special registration plates shall be designed
16 by the commissioner. Each application submitted pursuant to this
17 subdivision shall be accompanied by payment of a special initial
18 application fee of \$15, which is in addition to any other

6 sufficient proof of membership in the Harley Owners Group.

7 (B) The division shall charge a special initial application
8 fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by law. This
9 special fee shall be collected by the division and deposited in the
10 State Road Fund.

11 (C) An annual fee of \$15 shall be charged for each plate in
12 addition to all other fees required by this chapter.

13 (36) The division may issue special registration plates for
14 persons retired from any branch of the armed services of the United
15 States as follows:

16 (A) Upon appropriate application, there shall be issued to any
17 person who has retired after service in any branch of the armed
18 services of the United States, a special registration plate for any
19 number of vehicles titled in the name of the qualified applicant
20 with an insignia designed by the Commissioner of the Division of
21 Motor Vehicles to designate the recipient as retired from the armed
22 services of the United States.

23 (B) A special initial application fee of \$10 shall be charged
24 in addition to all other fees required by law. This special fee

1 shall be collected by the division and deposited in the State Road

12 number of vehicles titled in the name of the qualified applicant.

13 (B) The division shall charge a special initial application

16 State Road Fund.

17 (C) An annual fee of \$15 shall be charged for each plate in

19 (38) The division may issue special registration plates

19 Division Association special registration plates as follows:

20 (A) The division may issue a special registration plate for
21 members of the 82nd Airborne Division Association upon receipt of
22 a guarantee from the organization of a minimum of one hundred
23 applicants. The insignia on the plate shall be designed by the
24 commissioner.

1 (B) Upon appropriate application, the division may issue
2 members of the 82nd Airborne Division Association in good standing,
3 as determined by the governing body of the organization, a special
4 registration plate for any number of vehicles titled in the name of
5 the qualified applicant.

6 (C) The division shall charge a special one-time initial
7 application fee of \$10 for each special license plate in addition
8 to all other fees required by this chapter. All initial application
9 fees collected by the division shall be deposited into the State
10 Road Fund: *Provided*, That nothing in this section may be construed
11 to exempt the applicant from any other provision of this chapter.

12 (D) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased

3 (B) The division shall charge a special initial application

18 political or social belief, as determined by the commissioner in
19 his or her sole discretion;

20 (iv) The organization may not have as its primary purpose the
21 promotion of any specific faith, religion, religious belief or
22 antireligion;

23 (v) The name of the organization may not be the name of a
24 special product or brand name, and may not be construed, as

1 determined by the commissioner, as promoting a product or brand
2 name; and

3 (vi) The organization's lettering, logo, image or message to
4 be placed on the registration plate, if created, may not be
5 obscene, offensive or objectionable as determined by the
6 commissioner in his or her sole discretion.

7 (B) Beginning July 1, 2010, an organization requesting the
8 creation and issuance of a special registration plate may make
9 application with the division. The application shall include
10 sufficient information, as determined by the commissioner, to
11 determine whether the special registration plate requested and the
12 organization making the application meet all of the requirements
13 set forth in this subdivision (60). The application shall also
14 include a proposed design, including lettering, logo, image or
15 message to be placed on the registration plate. The commissioner
16 shall notify the organization of the commissioner's approval or
17 disapproval of the application.

18 (C) (i) The commissioner may not begin the design or production
19 of any license plates authorized and approved pursuant to this
20 subdivision (60), subsection (c) of this section until the
21 organization which applied for the special registration plate has
22 collected and submitted collectively to the division applications
23 completed by at least two hundred fifty persons and collectively
24 deposited with the division all fees necessary to cover the first

1 year's basic registration, one-time design and manufacturing costs
2 and to cover the first year additional annual fee for all of the
3 applications submitted.

4 (ii) If the organization fails to submit the required number
5 of applications and fees within six months of the effective date of
6 the approval of the application for the plate by the commissioner,
7 the plate will not be produced until a new application is submitted
8 and is approved by the commissioner: *Provided*, That an organization
9 that is unsuccessful in obtaining the minimum number of
10 applications may not make a new application for a special plate
11 until at least two years have passed since the approval of the
12 previous application of the organization.

13 (D) The division shall charge a special initial application
14 fee of \$25 for each special license plate in addition to all other
15 fees required by law. This special fee shall be collected by the
16 division and deposited in the State Road Fund.

17 (E) The division shall charge an annual fee of \$15 for each
18 special registration plate in addition to all other fees required
19 by this chapter.

20 (F) Upon appropriate application, the division may issue a
21 special registration plate designed by the commissioner in
22 consultation with the organization for any number of vehicles
23 titled in the name of a qualified registration plate applicant.
24 Persons desiring the special registration plate shall offer

1 sufficient proof of membership in the organization.

2 (G) The commissioner shall discontinue the issuance or renewal
3 of the registration of any special plate issued pursuant to this
4 subdivision (60) if:

5 (i) The number of valid registrations for the specialty plate
6 falls below two hundred fifty plates for at least twelve
7 consecutive months; or

8 (ii) The organization no longer exists or no longer meets the
9 requirements of this subdivision.

10 (d) The minimum number of applications required prior to
11 design and production of a special license plate shall be as
12 follows:

13 (1) The commissioner may not begin the design or production of
14 any license plates for which eligibility is based on membership or
15 affiliation with a particular private organization until at least
16 one hundred persons complete an application and deposit with the
17 organization a check to cover the first year's basic registration,
18 one-time design and manufacturing costs and to cover the first year
19 additional annual fee. If the organization fails to submit the
20 required number of applications with attached checks within six
21 months of the effective date of the original authorizing
22 legislation, the plate will not be produced and will require
23 legislative reauthorization: *Provided*, That an organization or
24 group that is unsuccessful in obtaining the minimum number of

1 applications may not request reconsideration of a special plate
2 until at least two years have passed since the effective date of
3 the original authorization: *Provided, however,* That the provisions
4 of this subdivision (1) are not applicable to the issuance of
5 plates authorized pursuant to subdivision (60), subsection (c) of
6 this section.

7 (2) The commissioner may not begin the design or production of
8 any license plates authorized by this section for which membership
9 or affiliation with a particular organization is not required until
10 at least two hundred fifty registrants complete an application and
11 deposit a fee with the division to cover the first year's basic
12 registration fee, one-time design and manufacturing fee and
13 additional annual fee if applicable. If the commissioner fails to
14 receive the required number of applications within six months of
15 the effective date of the original authorizing legislation, the
16 plate will not be produced and will require legislative
17 reauthorization: *Provided,* That if the minimum number of
18 applications is not satisfied within the six months of the
19 effective date of the original authorizing legislation, a person
20 may not request reconsideration of a special plate until at least
21 two years have passed since the effective date of the original
22 authorization.

23 (e) (1) Nothing in this section requires a charge for a free
24 prisoner of war license plate or a free recipient of the

1 Congressional Medal of Honor license plate for a vehicle titled in
2 the name of the qualified applicant as authorized by other
3 provisions of this code.

4 (2) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased
5 spouse's prisoner of war license plate or Congressional Medal of
6 Honor license plate until the surviving spouse dies, remarries or
7 does not renew the license plate.

8 (3) Qualified former prisoners of war and recipients of the
9 Congressional Medal of Honor may obtain a second special
10 registration plate for use on a passenger vehicle titled in the
11 name of the qualified applicant. The division shall charge a
12 one-time fee of \$10 to be deposited into the State Road Fund, in
13 addition to all other fees required by this chapter, for the second
14 special plate.

15 (f) The division may issue special ten-year registration
16 plates as follows:

17 (1) The commissioner may issue or renew for a period of no
18 more than ten years any registration plate exempted from
19 registration fees pursuant to any provision of this code or any
20 restricted use antique motor vehicle license plate authorized by
21 section three-a, article ten of this chapter: *Provided*, That the
22 provisions of this subsection do not apply to any person who has
23 had a special registration suspended for failure to maintain motor
24 vehicle liability insurance as required by section three, article

1 two-a, chapter seventeen-d of this code or failure to pay personal
2 property taxes as required by section three-a of this article.

3 (2) An initial nonrefundable fee shall be charged for each
4 special registration plate issued pursuant to this subsection,
5 which is the total amount of fees required by section fifteen,
6 article ten of this chapter, section three, article three of this
7 chapter or section three-a, article ten of this chapter for the
8 period requested.

9 (g) The provisions of this section may not be construed to
10 exempt any registrant from maintaining motor vehicle liability
11 insurance as required by section three, article two-a, chapter
12 seventeen-d of this code or from paying personal property taxes on
13 any motor vehicle as required by section three-a of this article.

14 (h) The commissioner may, in his or her discretion, issue a
15 registration plate of reflectorized material suitable for permanent
16 use on motor vehicles, trailers and semitrailers, together with
17 appropriate devices to be attached to the registration to indicate
18 the year for which the vehicles have been properly registered or
19 the date of expiration of the registration. The design and
20 expiration of the plates shall be determined by the commissioner.
21 The commissioner shall, whenever possible and cost effective,
22 implement the latest technology in the design, production and
23 issuance of registration plates, indices of registration renewal
24 and vehicle ownership documents, including, but not limited to,

1 offering Internet renewal of vehicle registration and the use of
2 bar codes for instant identification of vehicles by scanning
3 equipment to promote the efficient and effective coordination and
4 communication of data for improving highway safety, aiding law
5 enforcement and enhancing revenue collection.

6 (i) Any license plate issued or renewed pursuant to this
7 chapter which is paid for by a check that is returned for
8 nonsufficient funds is void without further notice to the
9 applicant. The applicant may not reinstate the registration until
10 the returned check is paid by the applicant in cash, money order or
11 certified check and all applicable fees assessed as a result
12 thereof have been paid.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide a discounted motor vehicle registration fee to members of volunteer fire departments. Members would receive two years' motor vehicle registration upon payment of a one-year registration fee.
