11	A BILL to amend and reenact sections 1, 2 and 3, chapter 232, Acts
12	of the Legislature, regular session, 1997, all relating to
13	expanding the counties covered by West Virginia Route 2 and
14	Interstate 68 Authority to include Cabell, Mason and Jackson
15	counties; and increasing the number of voting members from
16	twenty to twenty-six.
17	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
18	That sections 1, 2 and 3, chapter 232, Acts of the
19	Legislature, regular session, 1997, be amended and reenacted, all
20	to read as follows:
21	WEST VIRGINIA ROUTE 2 AND INTERSTATE 68 AUTHORITY.
22	§1. West Virginia Route 2 and Interstate 68 Authority created;
23	purposes.

There is hereby created a West Virginia Route 2 and Interstate 2 68 Authority to promote and advance the construction of a modern 3 highway through Cabell, Mason, Jackson, Wood, Pleasants, Tyler, 4 Wetzel, Marshall, Ohio, Brooke, Hancock, Marion and Monongalia 5 counties and to coordinate with counties, municipalities, state and 6 federal agencies, public nonprofit corporations, private 7 corporations, associations, partnerships and individuals for the 8 purpose of planning, assisting and establishing recreational, 9 tourism, industrial, economic and community development of West 10 Virginia Route 2 between Huntington, Parkersburg and Chester and 11 Interstate 68 between Moundsville and Morgantown for the benefit of 12 West Virginians.

13 §2. Members; appointment; officers.

(a) The authority consists of twenty twenty-six voting members and three ex officio nonvoting members. All members shall be appointed before July 1, 1997, except that the members from Cabell, Mason and Jackson counties shall be appointed before July 1, 2014.

(b) Each of the county commissions of the counties of Cabell, Mason, Jackson, Wood, Pleasants, Tyler, Wetzel, Marshall, Ohio, Brooke, Hancock, Marion and Monongalia shall appoint two voting members to the authority. The terms of the voting members initially appointed by a county commission are as follows: One member shall be appointed for a term of two years and one member shall be appointed for a term of four years. All successive appointments

- 1 shall be are for a term of four years. Any voting member may be
- 2 removed for cause by the appointing county commission.
- 3 (c) The three ex officio nonvoting members are the
- 4 Commissioner of Highways or designee, the Director of Natural
- 5 Resources or designee and the Executive Director of the West
- 6 Virginia Development Office or designee.
- 7 (d) Should a vacancy occur, the person appointed to fill the
- 8 vacancy shall serve serves only for the unexpired portion thereof
- 9 of the term. All members are eligible for reappointment.
- 10 (e) The authority shall meet annually on the third Monday in
- 11 July and at such other times designated by the authority in its
- 12 bylaws. A special meeting may be called by the president, the
- 13 secretary or any two members of the authority and may be held only
- 14 after all members are given notice of the meeting in writing.
- 15 Eleven Fourteen voting members constitute a quorum for all
- 16 meetings. At each annual meeting of the authority, it shall elect
- 17 a president, vice president, secretary and treasurer. The
- 18 authority shall adopt bylaws, rules as may be necessary for its
- 19 operation and management.

20 **§3.** Powers.

- 21 The authority has all but only those powers necessary,
- 22 incidental, convenient and advisable for the following purposes:
- 23 (1) The promotion of economic development and tourism along
- 24 West Virginia Route 2 between Huntington, Parkersburg and Chester

- 1 and Interstate 68, between Moundsville and Morgantown;
- 2 (2) Advocating actions consistent with that plan or its
- 3 provisions to or before any governmental entity or any private
- 4 person or entity; and
- 5 (3) Otherwise acting in an advisory capacity with regard to
- 6 any aspects of West Virginia Route 2 between Huntington,
- 7 Parkersburg and Chester and Interstate 68 between Moundsville and
- 8 Morgantown, at the request of or without the request of any
- 9 governmental entity or private person or entity.
- 10 The authority may not own any of the real estate or real
- 11 property herein described in this act for development and may not
- 12 be is not responsible for operating or maintaining the highways
- 13 described herein in this act.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to expand the counties covered by West Virginia Route 2 and Interstate 68 Authority to include Cabell, Mason and Jackson counties. The bill also increases the number of voting members from twenty to twenty-six.
