17	be amended and reenacted to read as follows:	
18	ARTICLE 3. ORIGINAL AND RENEWAL OF REGISTRATION; ISSUANCE OF	
19	CERTIFICATES OF TITLE.	
20	<pre>\$17A-3-14. Registration plates generally; description of plates;</pre>	
21	issuance of special numbers and plates;	
22	registration fees; special application fees;	

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exemptions; commissioner to promulgate forms; suspension and nonrenewal.

3 (a) The division upon registering a vehicle shall issue to the 4 owner one registration plate for a motorcycle, trailer, semitrailer 5 or other motor vehicle.

6 (b) Registration plates issued by the division shall meet the 7 following requirements:

8 (1) Every registration plate shall be of reflectorized 9 material and have displayed upon it the registration number 10 assigned to the vehicle for which it is issued; the name of this 11 state, which may be abbreviated; and the year number for which it 12 is issued or the date of expiration of the plate.

13 (2) Every registration plate and the required letters and 14 numerals on the plate shall be of sufficient size to be plainly 15 readable from a distance of one hundred feet during daylight: 16 *Provided*, That the requirements of this subdivision shall not apply 17 to the year number for which the plate is issued or the date of 18 expiration.

19 (3) Registration numbering for registration plates shall begin20 with number two.

(c) The division may not issue, permit to be issued or
22 distribute any special registration plates except as follows:
(1) The Governor shall be issued two registration plates, on

1 one of which shall be imprinted the numeral one and on the other 2 the word one.

3 (2) State officials and judges may be issued special 4 registration plates as follows:

5 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue to 6 the Secretary of State, State Superintendent of Schools, Auditor, 7 Treasurer, Commissioner of Agriculture and the Attorney General, 8 the members of both houses of the Legislature, including the 9 elected officials of both houses of the Legislature, the justices 10 of the Supreme Court of Appeals of West Virginia, the 11 representatives and senators of the state in the Congress of the 12 United States, the judges of the West Virginia circuit courts, 13 active and retired on senior status, the judges of the United 14 States district courts for the State of West Virginia and the 15 judges of the United States Court of Appeals for the fourth 16 circuit, if any of the judges are residents of West Virginia, a 17 special registration plate for a Class A motor vehicle and a 18 special registration plate for a Class G motorcycle owned by the 19 official or his or her spouse: *Provided*, That the division may 20 issue a Class A special registration plate for each vehicle titled 21 to the official and a Class G special registration plate for each 22 motorcycle titled to the official.

23 (B) Each plate issued pursuant to this subdivision shall bear

1 any combination of letters and numbers not to exceed an amount 2 determined by the commissioner and a designation of the office. 3 Each plate shall supersede the regular numbered plate assigned to 4 the official or his or her spouse during the official's term of 5 office and while the motor vehicle is owned by the official or his 6 or her spouse.

7 (C) The division shall charge an annual fee of \$15 for every 8 registration plate issued pursuant to this subdivision, which is in 9 addition to all other fees required by this chapter.

10 (3) The division may issue members of the National Guard 11 forces special registration plates as follows:

(A) Upon receipt of an application on a form prescribed by the division and receipt of written evidence from the chief executive deficer of the Army National Guard or Air National Guard, as propriate, or the commanding officer of any United States Armed Forces reserve unit that the applicant is a member thereof, the division shall issue to any member of the National Guard of this state or a member of any reserve unit of the United States Armed Porces a special registration plate designed by the commissioner of for any number of Class A motor vehicles owned by the member. Upon presentation of written evidence of retirement status, retired members of this state's Army or Air National Guard, or retired members of any reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces, are

1 eligible to purchase the special registration plate issued pursuant 2 to this subdivision.

3 (B) The division shall charge an initial application fee of 4 \$10 for each special registration plate issued pursuant to this 5 subdivision, which is in addition to all other fees required by 6 this chapter. Except as otherwise provided herein, effective July 7 1, 2007, all fees currently held in the special revolving fund used 8 in the administration of this section and all fees collected by the 9 division shall be deposited in the State Road Fund.

10 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased 11 spouse's National Guard forces license plate until the surviving 12 spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the license plate.

13 (4) Specially arranged registration plates may be issued as 14 follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, any owner of a motor vehicle subject to Class A registration, or a motorcycle subject to Class r G registration, as defined by this article, may request that the division issue a registration plate bearing specially arranged letters or numbers with the maximum number of letters or numbers to be determined by the commissioner. The division shall attempt to comply with the request wherever possible.

22 (B) The commissioner shall propose rules for legislative 23 approval in accordance with the provisions of chapter twenty-nine-a

1 of this code regarding the orderly distribution of the plates: 2 Provided, That for purposes of this subdivision, the registration 3 plates requested and issued shall include all plates bearing the 4 numbers two through two thousand.

5 (C) An annual fee of \$15 shall be charged for each special 6 registration plate issued pursuant to this subdivision, which is in 7 addition to all other fees required by this chapter.

8 (5) The division may issue honorably discharged veterans 9 special registration plates as follows:

10 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue to 11 any honorably discharged veteran of any branch of the armed 12 services of the United States a special registration plate for any 13 number of vehicles titled in the name of the qualified applicant 14 with an insignia designed by the Commissioner of the Division of 15 Motor Vehicles.

16 (B) The division shall charge a special initial application 17 fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by law. This 18 special fee is to compensate the Division of Motor Vehicles for 19 additional costs and services required in the issuing of the 20 special registration. All fees collected by the division shall be 21 deposited in the State Road Fund: *Provided*, That nothing in this 22 section may be construed to exempt any veteran from any other 23 provision of this chapter.

1 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased 2 spouse's honorably discharged veterans license plate until the 3 surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the license 4 plate.

5 (6) The division may issue disabled veterans special 6 registration plates as follows:

7 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue to 8 any disabled veteran who is exempt from the payment of registration 9 fees under the provisions of this chapter a registration plate for 10 a vehicle titled in the name of the qualified applicant which bears 11 the letters "DV" in red and also the regular identification 12 numerals in red.

(B) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased 14 spouse's disabled veterans license plate until the surviving spouse 15 dies, remarries or does not renew the license plate.

(C) A qualified disabled veteran may obtain a second disabled veterans license plate as described in this section for use on a passenger vehicle titled in the name of the qualified applicant. The division shall charge a one-time fee of \$10 to be deposited into the State Road Fund, in addition to all other fees required by this chapter, for the second plate.

(7) The division may issue recipients of the distinguished23 Purple Heart medal special registration plates as follows:

1 (A) Upon appropriate application, there shall be issued to any 2 armed service person holding the distinguished Purple Heart medal 3 for persons wounded in combat a registration plate for a vehicle 4 titled in the name of the qualified applicant bearing letters or 5 numbers. The registration plate shall be designed by the 6 Commissioner of Motor Vehicles and shall denote that those 7 individuals who are granted this special registration plate are 8 recipients of the Purple Heart. All letterings shall be in purple 9 where practical.

10 (B) Registration plates issued pursuant to this subdivision 11 are exempt from all registration fees otherwise required by the 12 provisions of this chapter.

13 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased 14 spouse's Purple Heart medal license plate until the surviving 15 spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the license plate.

(D) A recipient of the Purple Heart medal may obtain a second Purple Heart medal license plate as described in this section for use on a passenger vehicle titled in the name of the qualified papplicant. The division shall charge a one-time fee of \$10 to be deposited into the State Road Fund, in addition to all other fees required by this chapter, for the second plate.

(8) The division may issue survivors of the attack on PearlHarbor special registration plates as follows:

1 (A) Upon appropriate application, the owner of a motor vehicle 2 who was enlisted in any branch of the armed services that 3 participated in and survived the attack on Pearl Harbor on December 4 7, 1941, the division shall issue a special registration plate for 5 a vehicle titled in the name of the qualified applicant. The 6 registration plate shall be designed by the Commissioner of Motor 7 Vehicles.

8 (B) Registration plates issued pursuant to this subdivision 9 are exempt from the payment of all registration fees otherwise 10 required by the provisions of this chapter.

11 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased 12 spouse's survivors of the attack on Pearl Harbor license plate 13 until the surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the 14 license plate.

(D) A survivor of the attack on Pearl Harbor may obtain a second survivors of the attack on Pearl Harbor license plate as described in this section for use on a passenger vehicle titled in the name of the qualified applicant. The division shall charge a one-time fee of \$10 to be deposited into the State Road Fund, in addition to all other fees required by this chapter, for the second plate.

(9) The division may issue special registration plates to23 nonprofit charitable and educational organizations authorized under

1 prior enactment of this subdivision as follows:

nonprofit charitable 2 (A) Approved and educational 3 organizations previously authorized under the prior enactment of 4 this subdivision may accept and collect applications for special 5 registration plates from owners of Class A motor vehicles together 6 with a special annual fee of \$15, which is in addition to all other 7 fees required by this chapter. The applications and fees shall be 8 submitted to the Division of Motor Vehicles with the request that 9 the division issue a registration plate bearing a combination of 10 letters or numbers with the organizations' logo or emblem, with the 11 maximum number of letters or numbers to be determined by the 12 commissioner.

(B) The commissioner shall propose rules for legislative approval in accordance with the provisions of article three, chapter twenty-nine-a of this code regarding the procedures for and approval of special registration plates issued pursuant to this subdivision.

18 (C) The commissioner shall set an appropriate fee to defray 19 the administrative associated with costs designing and 20 manufacturing special registration plates for а nonprofit 21 charitable or educational organization. The nonprofit charitable 22 or educational organization shall collect this fee and forward it 23 to the division for deposit in the State Road Fund. The nonprofit

1 charitable or educational organization may also collect a fee for 2 marketing the special registration plates.

3 (10) The division may issue specified emergency or volunteer 4 registration plates as follows:

5 (A) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a resident of the 6 State of West Virginia and who is a certified paramedic or 7 emergency medical technician, a member of a paid fire department, 8 a member of the State Fire Commission, the State Fire Marshal, the 9 State Fire Marshal's assistants, the state Fire Administrator and 10 voluntary rescue squad members may apply for a special license 11 plate for any number of Class A vehicles titled in the name of the 12 qualified applicant which bears the insignia of the profession, 13 group or commission. Any insignia shall be designed by the 14 commissioner. License plates issued pursuant to this subdivision 15 shall bear the requested insignia in addition to the registration 16 number issued to the applicant pursuant to the provisions of this 17 article.

(B) Each application submitted pursuant to this subdivision 19 shall be accompanied by an affidavit signed by the fire chief or 20 department head of the applicant stating that the applicant is 21 justified in having a registration with the requested insignia; 22 proof of compliance with all laws of this state regarding 23 registration and licensure of motor vehicles; and payment of all

1 required fees.

2 (C) Each application submitted pursuant to this subdivision 3 shall be accompanied by payment of a special initial application 4 fee of \$10, which is in addition to any other registration or 5 license fee required by this chapter. All special fees shall be 6 collected by the division and deposited into the State Road Fund. 7 (11) The division may issue specified certified firefighter 8 registration plates as follows:

9 (A) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a resident of the 10 State of West Virginia and who is a certified firefighter may apply 11 for a special license plate which bears the insignia of the 12 profession, for any number of Class A vehicles titled in the name 13 of the qualified applicant. Any insignia shall be designed by the 14 commissioner. License plates issued pursuant to this subdivision 15 shall bear the requested insignia pursuant to the provisions of 16 this article. Upon presentation of written evidence of 17 certification as a certified firefighter, certified firefighters 18 are eligible to purchase the special registration plate issued 19 pursuant to this subdivision.

(B) Each application submitted pursuant to this subdivision 21 shall be accompanied by an affidavit stating that the applicant is 22 justified in having a registration with the requested insignia; 23 proof of compliance with all laws of this state regarding

1 registration and licensure of motor vehicles; and payment of all 2 required fees. The firefighter certification department, section 3 or division of the West Virginia University fire service extension 4 shall notify the commissioner in writing immediately when a 5 firefighter loses his or her certification. If a firefighter loses 6 his or her certification, the commissioner may not issue him or her 7 a license plate under this subsection.

8 (C) Each application submitted pursuant to this subdivision 9 shall be accompanied by payment of a special initial application 10 fee of \$10, which is in addition to any other registration or 11 license fee required by this chapter. All special fees shall be 12 collected by the division and deposited into the State Road Fund. 13 (12) The division may issue special scenic registration plates

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14 as follows:
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(A) Upon appropriate application, the commissioner shall issue a special registration plate displaying a scenic design of West Virginia which displays the words "Wild Wonderful" as a slogan.

(B) The division shall charge a special one-time initial 19 application fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by 20 this chapter. All initial application fees collected by the 21 division shall be deposited into the State Road Fund.

(13) The division may issue honorably discharged Marine Corpsleague members special registration plates as follows:

1 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue to 2 any honorably discharged Marine Corps league member a special 3 registration plate for any number of vehicles titled in the name of 4 the qualified applicant with an insignia designed by the 5 Commissioner of the Division of Motor Vehicles.

6 (B) The division may charge a special one-time initial 7 application fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by 8 this chapter. This special fee is to compensate the Division of 9 Motor Vehicles for additional costs and services required in the 10 issuing of the special registration and shall be collected by the 11 division and deposited in the State Road Fund: *Provided*, That 12 nothing in this section may be construed to exempt any veteran from 13 any other provision of this chapter.

14 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased 15 spouse's honorably discharged Marine Corps League license plate 16 until the surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the 17 license plate.

18 (14) The division may issue military organization registration 19 plates as follows:

20 (A) The division may issue a special registration plate for 21 the members of any military organization chartered by the United 22 States Congress upon receipt of a guarantee from the organization 23 of a minimum of one hundred applicants. The insignia on the plate

1 shall be designed by the commissioner.

2 (B) Upon appropriate application, the division may issue 3 members of the chartered organization in good standing, as 4 determined by the governing body of the chartered organization, a 5 special registration plate for any number of vehicles titled in the 6 name of the qualified applicant.

7 (C) The division shall charge a special one-time initial 8 application fee of \$10 for each special license plate in addition 9 to all other fees required by this chapter. All initial 10 application fees collected by the division shall be deposited into 11 the State Road Fund: *Provided*, That nothing in this section may be 12 construed to exempt any veteran from any other provision of this 13 chapter.

(D) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased spouse's military organization registration plate until the surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the special military organization registration plate.

18 (15) The division may issue special nongame wildlife 19 registration plates and special wildlife registration plates as 20 follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue a 22 special registration plate displaying a species of West Virginia 23 wildlife which shall display a species of wildlife native to West

Virginia as prescribed and designated by the commissioner and the
 Director of the Division of Natural Resources.

3 (B) The division shall charge an annual fee of \$15 for each 4 special nongame wildlife registration plate and each special 5 wildlife registration plate in addition to all other fees required 6 by this chapter. All annual fees collected for nongame wildlife 7 registration plates and wildlife registration plates shall be 8 deposited in a special revenue account designated the Nongame 9 Wildlife Fund and credited to the Division of Natural Resources.

10 (C) The division shall charge a special one-time initial 11 application fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by 12 this chapter. All initial application fees collected by the 13 division shall be deposited in the State Road Fund.

14 (16) The division may issue members of the Silver Haired 15 Legislature special registration plates as follows:

16 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue to 17 any person who is a duly qualified member of the Silver Haired 18 Legislature a specialized registration plate which bears 19 recognition of the applicant as a member of the Silver Haired 20 Legislature.

(B) A qualified member of the Silver Haired Legislature may 22 obtain one registration plate described in this subdivision for use 23 on a passenger vehicle titled in the name of the qualified

applicant. The division shall charge an annual fee of \$15, in
 addition to all other fees required by this chapter, for the plate.
 All annual fees collected by the division shall be deposited in the
 4 State Road Fund.

5 (17) Upon appropriate application, the commissioner shall 6 issue to a classic motor vehicle or classic motorcycle as defined 7 in section three-a, article ten of this chapter, a special 8 registration plate designed by the commissioner. An annual fee of 9 \$15, in addition to all other fees required by this chapter, shall 10 be charged for each classic registration plate.

11 (18) Honorably discharged veterans may be issued special 12 registration plates for motorcycles subject to Class G registration 13 as follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, there shall be issued to any honorably discharged veteran of any branch of the armed services of the United States a special registration plate for any number of motorcycles subject to Class G registration titled in the name of the qualified applicant with an insignia designed by the Ocmmissioner of the Division of Motor Vehicles.

(B) A special initial application fee of \$10 shall be charged in addition to all other fees required by law. This special fee is collected by the division and deposited in the State Road Fund: *Provided*, That nothing in this section may be construed to

1 exempt any veteran from any other provision of this chapter.

2 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased 3 spouse's honorably discharged veterans license plate until the 4 surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the license 5 plate.

6 (19) Racing theme special registration plates:

7 (A) The division may issue a series of special registration
8 plates displaying National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing
9 themes.

10 (B) An annual fee of \$25 shall be charged for each special 11 racing theme registration plate in addition to all other fees 12 required by this chapter. All annual fees collected for each 13 special racing theme registration plate shall be deposited into the 14 State Road Fund.

15 (C) A special application fee of \$10 shall be charged at the 16 time of initial application as well as upon application for any 17 duplicate or replacement registration plate, in addition to all 18 other fees required by this chapter. All application fees shall be 19 deposited into the State Road Fund.

20 (20) The division may issue recipients of the Navy Cross, 21 Distinguished Service Cross, Distinguished Flying Cross, Air Force 22 Cross, Bronze Star, Silver Star or Air Medal special registration 23 plates as follows:

1 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue to 2 any recipient of the Navy Cross, Distinguished Service Cross, 3 Distinguished Flying Cross, Air Force Cross, Silver Star, Bronze 4 Star or Air Medal, a registration plate for any number of vehicles 5 titled in the name of the qualified applicant bearing letters or 6 numbers. A separate registration plate shall be designed by the 7 Commissioner of Motor Vehicles for each award that denotes that 8 those individuals who are granted this special registration plate 9 are recipients of the Navy Cross, Distinguished Service Cross, 10 Distinguished Flying Cross, Air Force Cross, Silver Star or Bronze 11 Star, or Air Medal as applicable.

12 (B) The division shall charge a special initial application 13 fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by law. This 14 special fee shall be collected by the division and deposited in the 15 State Road Fund: *Provided*, That nothing in this section exempts 16 the applicant for a special registration plate under this 17 subdivision from any other provision of this chapter.

(C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased spouse's Navy Cross, Distinguished Service Cross, Distinguished Plying Cross, Air Force Cross, Silver Star, Bronze Star or Air Medal special registration plate until the surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the special registration plate.

23 (21) The division may issue honorably discharged veterans

1 special registration plates as follows:

2 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue to 3 any honorably discharged veteran of any branch of the armed 4 services of the United States with verifiable service during World 5 War II, the Korean War, the Vietnam War, the Persian Gulf War or 6 the War Against Terrorism a special registration plate for any 7 number of vehicles titled in the name of the qualified applicant 8 with an insignia designed by the commissioner denoting service in 9 the applicable conflict.

10 (B) The division shall charge a special one-time initial 11 application fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by 12 law. This special fee shall be collected by the division and 13 deposited in the State Road Fund: *Provided*, That nothing contained 14 in this section may be construed to exempt any veteran from any 15 other provision of this chapter.

16 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased 17 spouse's honorably discharged veterans registration plate until the 18 surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the special 19 registration plate.

20 (22) The division may issue special volunteer firefighter 21 registration plates as follows:

(A) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a resident of WestVirginia and who is a volunteer firefighter may apply for a special

1 license plate for any Class A vehicle titled in the name of the 2 qualified applicant which bears the insignia of the profession in 3 white letters on a red background. The insignia shall be designed 4 by the commissioner and shall contain a fireman's helmet insignia 5 on the left side of the license plate.

6 (B) Each application submitted pursuant to this subdivision 7 shall be accompanied by an affidavit signed by the applicant's fire 8 chief, stating that the applicant is a volunteer firefighter and 9 justified in having a registration plate with the requested 10 insignia. The applicant must comply with all other laws of this 11 state regarding registration and licensure of motor vehicles and 12 must pay all required fees.

13 (C) Each application submitted pursuant to this subdivision 14 shall be accompanied by payment of a special one-time initial 15 application fee of \$10, which is in addition to any other 16 registration or license fee required by this chapter. All 17 application fees shall be deposited into the State Road Fund.

18 (23) The division may issue special registration plates which 19 reflect patriotic themes, including the display of any United 20 States symbol, icon, phrase or expression which evokes patriotic 21 pride or recognition.

(A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue toan applicant a registration plate of the applicant's choice,

1 displaying a patriotic theme as provided in this subdivision, for 2 a vehicle titled in the name of the applicant. A series of 3 registration plates displaying patriotic themes shall be designed 4 by the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles for distribution to 5 applicants.

6 (B) The division shall charge a special one-time initial 7 application fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by 8 law. This special fee shall be collected by the division and 9 deposited in the State Road Fund.

10 (24) Special license plates bearing the American flag and the 11 logo "9/11/01".

12 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue 13 special registration plates which shall display the American flag 14 and the logo "9/11/01".

(B) An annual fee of \$15 shall be charged for each plate in16 addition to all other fees required by this chapter.

17 (C) A special application fee of \$10 shall be charged at the 18 time of initial application as well as upon application for any 19 duplicate or replacement registration plate, in addition to all 20 other fees required by this chapter. All application fees shall be 21 deposited into the State Road Fund.

22 (25) The division may issue a special registration plate 23 celebrating the centennial of the 4-H youth development movement

1 and honoring the Future Farmers of America organization as follows: 2 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division may issue a 3 special registration plate depicting the symbol of the 4-H 4 organization which represents the head, heart, hands and health as 5 well as the symbol of the Future Farmers of America organization 6 which represents a cross section of an ear of corn for any number 7 of vehicles titled in the name of the qualified applicant.

8 (B) The division shall charge a special initial application 9 fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by law. This 10 special fee shall be collected by the division and deposited in the 11 State Road Fund.

12 (C) The division shall charge an annual fee of \$15 for each 13 special 4-H Future Farmers of America registration plate in 14 addition to all other fees required by this chapter.

15 (26) The division may issue special registration plates to 16 educators in the state's elementary and secondary schools and in 17 the state's institutions of higher education as follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, the division may issue a
19 special registration plate designed by the commissioner for any
20 number of vehicles titled in the name of the qualified applicant.
(B) The division shall charge a special initial application
22 fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by law. This
23 special fee shall be collected by the division and deposited in the

1 State Road Fund.

7 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division may issue a 8 special registration plate designed by the commissioner for any 9 number of vehicles titled in the name of the qualified applicant. 10 Persons desiring the special registration plate shall offer 11 sufficient proof of membership in Nemesis Shrine.

12 (B) The division shall charge a special initial application 13 fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by law. This 14 special fee shall be collected by the division and deposited in the 15 State Road Fund.

16 (C) An annual fee of \$15 shall be charged for each plate in 17 addition to all other fees required by this chapter.

(D) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (d) of this 19 section, the time period for the Nemesis Shrine to comply with the 20 minimum one hundred prepaid applications is hereby extended to 21 January 15, 2005.

This special fee 3 shall be collected by the division and deposited in the State Road 4 Fund: *Provided*, That nothing in this section may be construed to 5 exempt any veteran from any other provision of this chapter.

6 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his deceased 7 spouse's honorably discharged veterans license plate until the 8 surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the license 9 plate.

12 (C) An annual fee of \$15 shall be charged for each plate in 13 addition to all other fees required by this chapter.

(C) (I) The commissioner may not begin the design or production 14 of any license plates authorized and approved pursuant to this 15 subdivision (60), subsection (c) of this section until the 16 organization which applied for the special registration plate has 17 collected and submitted collectively to the division applications 18 completed by at least two hundred fifty persons and collectively 19 deposited with the division all fees necessary to cover the first 20 year's basic registration, one-time design and manufacturing costs 21 and to cover the first year additional annual fee for all of the 22 applications submitted.

23 (ii) If the organization fails to submit the required number

1 of applications and fees within six months of the effective date of 2 the approval of the application for the plate by the commissioner, 3 the plate will not be produced until a new application is submitted 4 and is approved by the commissioner: *Provided*, That an 5 organization that is unsuccessful in obtaining the minimum number 6 of applications may not make a new application for a special plate 7 until at least two years have passed since the approval of the 8 previous application of the organization.

9 (D) The division shall charge a special initial application 10 fee of \$25 for each special license plate in addition to all other 11 fees required by law. This special fee shall be collected by the 12 division and deposited in the State Road Fund.

13 (E) The division shall charge an annual fee of \$15 for each 14 special registration plate in addition to all other fees required 15 by this chapter.

(F) Upon appropriate application, the division may issue a registration plate designed by the commissioner in consultation with the organization for any number of vehicles titled in the name of a qualified registration plate applicant. Persons desiring the special registration plate shall offer sufficient proof of membership in the organization.

(G) The commissioner shall discontinue the issuance or renewalof the registration of any special plate issued pursuant to this

1 subdivision (60) if:

2 (I) The number of valid registrations for the specialty plate 3 falls below two hundred fifty plates for at least twelve 4 consecutive months; or

5 (ii) The organization no longer exists or no longer meets the 6 requirements of this subdivision.

7 (d) The minimum number of applications required prior to 8 design and production of a special license plate shall be as 9 follows:

(1) The commissioner may not begin the design or production of any license plates for which eligibility is based on membership or affiliation with a particular private organization until at least one hundred persons complete an application and deposit with the a organization a check to cover the first year's basic registration, one-time design and manufacturing costs and to cover the first year additional annual fee. If the organization fails to submit the required number of applications with attached checks within six months of the effective date of the original authorizing legislation, the plate will not be produced and will require legislative reauthorization: *Provided*, That an organization or group that is unsuccessful in obtaining the minimum number of applications may not request reconsideration of a special plate until at least two years have passed since the effective date of

1 the original authorization: *Provided, however*, That the provisions 2 of this subdivision (1) are not applicable to the issuance of 3 plates authorized pursuant to subdivision (60), subsection (c) of 4 this section.

5 (2) The commissioner may not begin the design or production of 6 any license plates authorized by this section for which membership 7 or affiliation with a particular organization is not required until 8 at least two hundred fifty registrants complete an application and 9 deposit a fee with the division to cover the first year's basic 10 registration fee, one-time design and manufacturing fee and 11 additional annual fee if applicable. If the commissioner fails to 12 receive the required number of applications within six months of 13 the effective date of the original authorizing legislation, the 14 plate will not be produced and will require legislative 15 reauthorization: Provided, That if the minimum number of 16 applications is not satisfied within the six months of the 17 effective date of the original authorizing legislation, a person 18 may not request reconsideration of a special plate until at least 19 two years have passed since the effective date of the original 20 authorization.

(e) (1) Nothing in this section requires a charge for a free prisoner of war license plate or a free recipient of the Congressional Medal of Honor license plate for a vehicle titled in

1 the name of the qualified applicant as authorized by other 2 provisions of this code.

3 (2) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased 4 spouse's prisoner of war license plate or Congressional Medal of 5 Honor license plate until the surviving spouse dies, remarries or 6 does not renew the license plate.

7 (3) Qualified former prisoners of war and recipients of the 8 Congressional Medal of Honor may obtain a second special 9 registration plate for use on a passenger vehicle titled in the 10 name of the qualified applicant. The division shall charge a one-11 time fee of \$10 to be deposited into the State Road Fund, in 12 addition to all other fees required by this chapter, for the second 13 special plate.

14 (f) The division may issue special ten-year registration 15 plates as follows:

16 (1) The commissioner may issue or renew for a period of no 17 more than ten years any registration plate exempted from 18 registration fees pursuant to any provision of this code, <u>a Bronze</u> 19 <u>Star Medal registration plate authorized by subdivision (20)</u>, 20 <u>subsection (c) of this section</u> or any restricted use antique motor 21 vehicle license plate authorized by section three-a, article ten of 22 this chapter: *Provided*, That the provisions of this subsection do 23 not apply to any person who has had a special registration

1 suspended for failure to maintain motor vehicle liability insurance 2 as required by section three, article two-a, chapter seventeen-d of 3 this code or failure to pay personal property taxes as required by 4 section three-a of this article.

5 (2) An initial nonrefundable fee shall be charged for each 6 special registration plate issued pursuant to this subsection, 7 which is the total amount of fees required by section fifteen, 8 article ten of this chapter, section three, article three of this 9 chapter or section three-a, article ten of this chapter for the 10 period requested.

11 (g) The provisions of this section may not be construed to 12 exempt any registrant from maintaining motor vehicle liability 13 insurance as required by section three, article two-a, chapter 14 seventeen-d of this code or from paying personal property taxes on 15 any motor vehicle as required by section three-a of this article. (h) The commissioner may, in his or her discretion, issue a 16 17 registration plate of reflectorized material suitable for permanent 18 use on motor vehicles, trailers and semitrailers, together with 19 appropriate devices to be attached to the registration to indicate 20 the year for which the vehicles have been properly registered or 21 the date of expiration of the registration. The design and 22 expiration of the plates shall be determined by the commissioner. 23 The commissioner shall, whenever possible and cost effective,

1 implement the latest technology in the design, production and 2 issuance of registration plates, indices of registration renewal 3 and vehicle ownership documents, including, but not limited to, 4 offering Internet renewal of vehicle registration and the use of 5 bar codes for instant identification of vehicles by scanning 6 equipment to promote the efficient and effective coordination and 7 communication of data for improving highway safety, aiding law 8 enforcement and enhancing revenue collection.

9 (I) Any license plate issued or renewed pursuant to this 10 chapter which is paid for by a check that is returned for 11 nonsufficient funds is void without further notice to the 12 applicant. The applicant may not reinstate the registration until 13 the returned check is paid by the applicant in cash, money order or 14 certified check and all applicable fees assessed as a result 15 thereof have been paid.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to permit recipients of the Bronze Star to have ten-year vehicle registration plates.
