AN ACT to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated §11-13R-13, relating to expiration of the Strategic Research and Development Tax Credit.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated §11-13R-13, to read as follows:

# ARTICLE 13R. STRATEGIC RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT TAX CREDIT.

### §11-13R-13. Expiration of tax credit.

- 1 The Strategic Research and Development Tax Credit Act
- 2 terminates on January 1, 2014, and no credit is available to
- 3 any taxpayer for any qualified investment or expenditure
- 4 made on or after that date. Taxpayers which have gained
- 5 entitlement to the credit pursuant to qualified investment or
- 6 expenditure prior to January 1, 2014, retain that entitlement
- 7 and may apply the credit pursuant to the requirements and
- 8 limitations of this article.
