

# Senate Bill No. 341

(By Senators Kessler (Mr. President) and M. Hall,  
By Request of the Executive)

A BILL making a supplementary appropriation from the State Fund, State Excess Lottery Revenue Fund, to the Department of Health and Human Resources, Division of Human Services, fund 5365, fiscal year 2014, organization 0511, by supplementing and amending chapter four, Acts of the Legislature, regular session, 2013, known as the Budget Bill.

Whereas, The Governor submitted to the Legislature the Executive Budget Document on January 8, 2014, which included a Statement of the State Excess Lottery Revenue Fund, setting forth therein the unappropriated cash balance as of July 1, 2013, and further included the estimate of revenue for the fiscal year 2014, less

regular appropriations and other adjustments for the fiscal year 2014; and

Whereas, It appears from the Governor’s Statement of the State Excess Lottery Revenue Fund there now remains an unappropriated balance in the State Treasury which is available for appropriation during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014; therefore

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That chapter four, Acts of the Legislature, regular session, 2013, known as the Budget Bill, be supplemented and amended by adding to Title II, section five thereof, the following:
