Senate Bill No. 584

reported February 19, 2014.]

A BILL to amend and reenact §30-13-18 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to the Board of Registration for Professional Engineers; changing the renewal date for certificates, registrations and certificates of authorization for firms to January 1; authorizing annual or biennial renewal periods; authorizing renewal notification by mail or electronically; and providing expiration requirements.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §30-13-18 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 13. ENGINEERS.

§30-13-18. Renewal requirements.

1 (a) Commencing January 1, 2015, all certificates,
2 registrations and certificates of authorization for firms shall
3 be renewed annually or biennially on or before January 1.

4 (b) The board may issue certifications, registrations and
5 certificates of authorization for firms for the six-month period
6 from July 1, 2014, through December 31, 2014.

7 (c) At least one month prior to renewal, the secretary of
8 the board shall notify each person certified or registered, and
9 each firm holding a certification of authorization, by mail or
10 electronic means at the contact information provided to the
11 board.

12 (d) If a certification, registration or certificate of
13 authorization is not timely renewed, then it expires.

14 (e) The board may require reexamination and the
15 payment of penalty fees for a registration that has expired.
