

Senate Bill No. 631

(By Senator Snyder)

[Originating in the Committee on Government Organization;
reported February 21, 2014.]

A BILL to extend the time for the city council of the Town of Fayetteville, Fayette County, to meet as a levying body for the purpose of presenting to the voters of the city an election to supplement current funds for the laying, repair and maintenance of the streets and sidewalks, and for the purpose of paying all costs incurred in the laying of this additional levy from between March 7 and March 28 and the third Tuesday in April until May 31, 2014.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FAYETTEVILLE
MEETING AS A LEVYING BODY EXTENDED.**

§1. Extending time for the city council for the Town of Fayetteville to meet as a levying body for an election to

supplement current funds for the laying, repair and maintenance of the streets and sidewalks, and for the purpose of paying all costs incurred in the laying of the additional levy.

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of article eight, chapter
2 eleven of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, the
3 city council of the Town of Fayetteville, Fayette County, is
4 authorized to extend the time for its meeting as a levying
5 body, setting the levy rate and certifying its actions to the
6 State Auditor and the State Tax Commissioner from between
7 March 7 and March 28 and the third Tuesday in April until
8 May 31, 2014, for the purpose of submitting to the voters of
9 the Town of Fayetteville the question of supplementing
10 current funds for the laying, repair and maintenance of the
11 streets and sidewalks, and for the purpose of paying all costs
12 incurred in the laying of this additional levy.
