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11 AN ACT to amend and reenact §8-22A-2 and §8-22A-6 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as
12 amended, all relating to membership provisions in the West Virginia Municipal Police and
13 Firefighters Retirement System.

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

15 That §8-22A-2 and §8-22A-6 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be
16 amended and reenacted, all to read as follows:

17 **ARTICLE 22A. WEST VIRGINIA MUNICIPAL POLICE OFFICERS AND**
18 **FIREFIGHTERS RETIREMENT SYSTEM.**

19 **§8-22A-2. Definitions.**

20 As used in this article, unless a federal law or regulation or the context clearly requires a
21 different meaning:

1 (a) "Accrued benefit" means on behalf of any member two and six-tenths percent per year
2 of the member's final average salary for the first twenty years of credited service. Additionally, two
3 percent per year for twenty-one through twenty-five years and one percent per year for twenty-six
4 through thirty years will be credited with a maximum benefit of sixty-seven percent. A member's
5 accrued benefit may not exceed the limits of Section 415 of the Internal Revenue Code and is subject
6 to the provisions of section ten of this article.

7 (b) "Accumulated contributions" means the sum of all retirement contributions deducted from
8 the compensation of a member, or paid on his or her behalf as a result of covered employment,
9 together with regular interest on the deducted amounts.

10 (c) "Active military duty" means full-time duty in the active military service of the United
11 States Army, Navy, Air Force, Coast Guard or Marine Corps. The term does not include regularly
12 required training or other duty performed by a member of a reserve component or National Guard
13 unless the member can substantiate that he or she was called into the full-time active military service
14 of the United States and has received no compensation during the period of that duty from any board
15 or employer other than the Armed Forces.

16 (d) "Actuarial equivalent" means a benefit of equal value computed on the basis of the
17 mortality table and interest rates as set and adopted by the board in accordance with the provisions
18 of this article: *Provided*, That when used in the context of compliance with the federal maximum
19 benefit requirements of Section 415 of the Internal Revenue Code, "actuarial equivalent" shall be
20 computed using the mortality tables and interest rates required to comply with those requirements.

21 (e) "Annual compensation" means the wages paid to the member during covered employment

1 within the meaning of Section 3401(a) of the Internal Revenue Code, but determined without regard
2 to any rules that limit the remuneration included in wages based on the nature or location of
3 employment or services performed during the plan year plus amounts excluded under Section
4 414(h)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code and less reimbursements or other expense allowances, cash
5 or noncash fringe benefits or both, deferred compensation and welfare benefits. Annual
6 compensation for determining benefits during any determination period may not exceed the
7 maximum compensation allowed as adjusted for cost-of-living in accordance with section seven,
8 article ten-d, chapter five of this code and Section 401(a)(17) of the Internal Revenue Code.

9 (f) "Annual leave service" means accrued annual leave.

10 (g) "Annuity starting date" means the first day of the month for which an annuity is payable
11 after submission of a retirement application or the required beginning date, if earlier. For purposes
12 of this subsection, if retirement income payments commence after the normal retirement age,
13 "retirement" means the first day of the month following or coincident with the latter of the last day
14 the member worked in covered employment or the member's normal retirement age and after
15 completing proper written application for "retirement" on an application supplied by the board.

16 (h) "Board" means the Consolidated Public Retirement Board.

17 (i) "Covered employment" means either: (1) Employment as a full-time municipal police
18 officer or firefighter and the active performance of the duties required of that employment; or (2) the
19 period of time during which active duties are not performed but disability benefits are received under
20 this article; or (3) concurrent employment by a municipal police officer or firefighter in a job or jobs
21 in addition to his or her employment as a municipal police officer or firefighter in this plan where

1 the secondary employment requires the police officer or firefighter to be a member of another
2 retirement system which is administered by the Consolidated Public Retirement Board pursuant to
3 this code: *Provided*, That the police officer or firefighter contributes to the fund created in this article
4 the amount specified as the member's contribution in section eight of this article.

5 (j) "Credited service" means the sum of a member's years of service, active military duty and
6 disability service.

7 (k) "Dependent child" means either: (1) An unmarried person under age eighteen who is: (A)
8 A natural child of the member; (B) a legally adopted child of the member; (C) a child who at the time
9 of the member's death was living with the member while the member was an adopting parent during
10 any period of probation; or (D) a stepchild of the member residing in the member's household at the
11 time of the member's death; or (2) Any unmarried child under age twenty-three: (A) Who is enrolled
12 as a full-time student in an accredited college or university; (B) who was claimed as a dependent by
13 the member for federal income tax purposes at the time of the member's death; and (C) whose
14 relationship with the member is described in paragraph (A), (B) or (C), subdivision (1) of this
15 subsection.

16 (l) "Dependent parent" means the father or mother of the member who was claimed as a
17 dependent by the member for federal income tax purposes at the time of the member's death.

18 (m) "Disability service" means service credit received by a member, expressed in whole
19 years, fractions thereof or both, equal to one half of the whole years, fractions thereof, or both, during
20 which time a member receives disability benefits under this article.

21 (n) "Effective date" means January 1, 2010.

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(o) "Final average salary" means the average of the highest annual compensation received for covered employment by the member during any five consecutive plan years within the member's last ten years of service while employed, prior to any disability payment. If the member did not have annual compensation for the five full plan years preceding the member's attainment of normal retirement age and during that period the member received disability benefits under this article, then "final average salary" means the average of the monthly compensation which the member was receiving in the plan year prior to the initial disability. "Final average salary" does not include any lump sum payment for unused, accrued leave of any kind or character.

(p) "Full-time employment" means permanent employment of an employee by a participating municipality in a position which normally requires twelve months per year service and requires at least one thousand forty hours per year service in that position.

(q) "Fund" means the West Virginia Municipal Police Officers and Firefighters Retirement Fund created by this article.

(r) "Hour of service" means: (1) Each hour for which a member is paid or entitled to payment for covered employment during which time active duties are performed. These hours shall be credited to the member for the plan year in which the duties are performed; and (2) each hour for which a member is paid or entitled to payment for covered employment during a plan year but where no duties are performed due to vacation, holiday, illness, incapacity including disability, layoff, jury duty, military duty, leave of absence or any combination thereof and without regard to whether the employment relationship has terminated. Hours under this subdivision shall be calculated and

1 credited pursuant to West Virginia Division of Labor rules. A member will not be credited with any
2 hours of service for any period of time he or she is receiving benefits under section seventeen or
3 eighteen of this article; and (3) each hour for which back pay is either awarded or agreed to be paid
4 by the employing municipality, irrespective of mitigation of damages. The same hours of service
5 shall not be credited both under subdivision (1) or (2) of this subsection and under this subdivision.
6 Hours under this paragraph shall be credited to the member for the plan year or years to which the
7 award or agreement pertains, rather than the plan year in which the award, agreement or payment is
8 made.

9 (s) "Member" means, except as provided in section thirty-two of this article, a person hired
10 as a municipal police officer or municipal firefighter, as defined in this section, by a participating
11 municipal employer on or after January 1, 2010. A member shall remain a member until the benefits
12 to which he or she is entitled under this article are paid or forfeited.

13 (t) "Monthly salary" means the W-2 reportable compensation received by a member during
14 the month.

15 (u) "Municipality" has the meaning ascribed to it in this code.

16 (v) (1) "Municipal police officer" means an individual employed as a member of a paid police
17 department by a West Virginia municipality or municipal subdivision which has established and
18 maintains a municipal policemen's pension and relief fund, and who is not a member of, and not
19 eligible for membership in, a municipal policemen's pension and relief fund as provided in section
20 sixteen, article twenty-two of this chapter. Paid police department does not mean a department
21 whose employees are paid nominal salaries or wages or are paid only for services actually rendered

1 on an hourly basis.

2 (2) "Municipal firefighter" means an individual employed as a member of a paid fire
3 department by a West Virginia municipality or municipal subdivision which has established and
4 maintains a municipal firemen's pension and relief fund, and who is not a member of, and not
5 eligible for membership in, a municipal firemen's pension and relief fund as provided in section
6 sixteen, article twenty-two of this chapter. Paid fire department does not mean a department whose
7 employees are paid nominal salaries or wages or are paid only for services actually rendered on an
8 hourly basis.

9 (w) "Municipal subdivision" means any separate corporation or instrumentality established
10 by one or more municipalities, as permitted by law; and any public corporation charged by law with
11 the performance of a governmental function and whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more
12 municipalities.

13 (x) "Normal form" means a monthly annuity which is one twelfth of the amount of the
14 member's accrued benefit which is payable for the member's life. If the member dies before the sum
15 of the payments he or she receives equals his or her accumulated contributions on the annuity
16 starting date, the named beneficiary shall receive in one lump sum the difference between the
17 accumulated contributions at the annuity starting date and the total of the retirement income
18 payments made to the member.

19 (y) "Normal retirement age" means the first to occur of the following: (1) Attainment of age
20 fifty years and the completion of twenty or more years of regular contributory service; (2) while still
21 in covered employment, attainment of at least age fifty years and when the sum of current age plus

1 regular contributory service equals or exceeds seventy years; (3) while still in covered employment,
2 attainment of at least age sixty years and completion of ten years of regular contributory service; or
3 (4) Attainment of age sixty-two years and completion of five or more years of regular contributory
4 service.

5 (z) "Plan" means the West Virginia Municipal Police Officers and Firefighters Retirement
6 System established by this article.

7 (aa) "Plan year" means the twelve-month period commencing on January 1 of any designated
8 year and ending the following December 31.

9 (bb) "Qualified public safety employee" means any employee of a participating state or
10 political subdivision who provides police protection, firefighting services or emergency medical
11 services for any area within the jurisdiction of the state or political subdivision, or such other
12 meaning given to the term by Section 72(t)(10)(B) of the Internal Revenue Code or by Treasury
13 Regulation §1.401(a)-1(b)(2)(v) as they may be amended from time to time.

14 (cc) "Regular contributory service" means a member's credited service excluding active
15 military duty, disability service and accrued annual and sick leave service.

16 (dd) "Regular interest" means the rate or rates of interest per annum, compounded annually,
17 as the board adopts in accordance with the provisions of this article.

18 (ee) "Required beginning date" means April 1 of the calendar year following the later of: (1)
19 The calendar year in which the member attains age seventy and one-half; or (2) the calendar year in
20 which he or she retires or otherwise separates from covered employment.

21 (ff) "Retirement income payments" means the monthly retirement income payments payable

1 under the plan.

2 (gg) "Spouse" means the person to whom the member is legally married on the annuity
3 starting date.

4 (hh) "Surviving spouse" means the person to whom the member was legally married at the
5 time of the member's death and who survived the member.

6 (ii) "Totally disabled" means a member's inability to engage in substantial gainful activity
7 by reason of any medically determined physical or mental impairment that can be expected to result
8 in death or that has lasted or can be expected to last for a continuous period of not less than twelve
9 months. For purposes of this subsection: (1) A member is totally disabled only if his or her physical
10 or mental impairment or impairments is so severe that he or she is not only unable to perform his or
11 her previous work as a police officer or firefighter but also cannot, considering his or her age,
12 education and work experience, engage in any other kind of substantial gainful employment which
13 exists in the state regardless of whether: (A) The work exists in the immediate area in which the
14 member lives; (B) a specific job vacancy exists; or (C) the member would be hired if he or she
15 applied for work. For purposes of this article, substantial gainful employment is the same definition
16 as used by the United States Social Security Administration. (2) "Physical or mental impairment"
17 is an impairment that results from an anatomical, physiological or psychological abnormality that
18 is demonstrated by medically accepted clinical and laboratory diagnostic techniques. The board may
19 require submission of a member's annual tax return for purposes of monitoring the earnings
20 limitation.

21 (jj) "Year of service" means a member shall, except in his or her first and last years of

1 covered employment, be credited with years of service credit based on the hours of service
2 performed as covered employment and credited to the member during the plan year based on the
3 following schedule:

6	500 to 999	1/3

9 During a member's first and last years of covered employment, the member shall be credited
10 with one twelfth of a year of service for each month during the plan year in which the member is
11 credited with an hour of service for which contributions were received by the fund. A member is not
12 entitled to credit for years of service for any time period during which he or she received disability
13 payments under section seventeen or eighteen of this article.

14 **§8-22A-6. Members.**

15 (a) A police officer or firefighter hired in covered employment after the effective date of this
16 article by a municipality or municipal subdivision which has established and maintained a
17 policemen's pension and relief fund or a firemen's pension and relief fund pursuant to section sixteen,
18 article twenty-two of this chapter and which is a participating employer, shall be a member of this
19 retirement plan: *Provided*, That any police officer or firefighter who has concurrent employment in
20 an additional job or jobs which would require the police officer or firefighter to be a member of the
21 West Virginia Deputy Sheriff Retirement System or the West Virginia Emergency Medical Services

1 Retirement System shall participate in only one retirement system administered by the board, and
2 the retirement system applicable to the concurrent employment for which the employee has the
3 earliest date of hire shall prevail.

4 (b) Except as provided in section thirty-two of this article, a police officer or firefighter who
5 is a member of the Municipal Police Officers and Firefighters Retirement System may not have
6 credit for covered employment in any other retirement system applied as service credit in the
7 Municipal Police Officers and Firefighters Retirement System.

8 (c) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this article, any individual who is a leased
9 employee is not eligible to participate in the plan. For purposes of this plan, a "leased employee"
10 means any individual who performs services as an independent contractor or pursuant to an
11 agreement with an employee leasing organization or similar organization. If a question arises
12 regarding the status of an individual as a leased employee, the board has final power to decide the
13 question.

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
