Senate Bill No. 143
(By Senator Snyder)

[Introduced January 14, 2015; referred to the Committee on Finance; and then to the Committee
on the Judiciary.]

A BILL to amend and reenact article 2, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
relating to authorizing the Department of Administration to promulgate a legislative rule
relating to the state plan for the operation of the West Virginia State Agency for Surplus
Property.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 2, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and
reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 2. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION TO
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-2-1. Department of Administration.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 30, 2014, authorized under the
authority of section forty-four, article three, chapter five-a of this code, modified by the Department

1 of Administration to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and
2 refiled in the State Register on September 16, 2014, relating to the Department of Administration
3 (state plan for the operation of the West Virginia State Agency for Surplus Property, [148 CSR 4](#), is
4 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Administration to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the state plan for the operation of the West Virginia State Agency for Surplus Property.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
