A BILL to amend and reenact §17C-4-3 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to the duty to give information after a car crash; and requiring person involved in a car crash to provide certain insurance, vehicle owner information and exhibit his or her driver's license.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §17C-4-3 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 4. ACCIDENTS.

§17C-4-3. Duty to give information and render aid.

1 The driver of any vehicle involved in a crash resulting in injury to or death of any person or

2 damage to any vehicle which is driven or attended by any person shall give his or her name, address

3 and the registration number of the vehicle he or she is driving, proof of insurance, insurance policy

4 number and the name and address of the owner of the vehicle, if different, and shall upon request

5 and if available exhibit his or her driver's license to the person struck or the driver or occupant of

6 or person attending any vehicle collided with and shall render to any person injured in such crash

7 reasonable assistance, including the carrying, or the making arrangements for the carrying, of such

8 person to a physician, surgeon or hospital for medical or surgical treatment if it is apparent that such

9 treatment is necessary or if such carrying is requested by the injured person.

(NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require a person involved in a car crash to provide certain insurance and car owner information.
