11	A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
12	designated §16-5-20a, relating to a certificate of birth resulting in stillbirth.
13	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
14	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new
15	section, designated §16-5-20a, to read as follows:
16	ARTICLE 5. VITAL STATISTICS.
17	§16-5-20a. Certificate of birth resulting in stillbirth.
18	(a) Following a report of fetal death as required by section twenty of this article, either the
19	mother of father of a stillborn child may request that a certificate of birth resulting in stillbirth be
20	issued by the State Registrar. A certificate may only be requested by the mother of the child if:
21	(1) the child has not been legitimized;
22	(2) a court has not determined the paternity of the child;
23	(3) if no father has been identified; or

- 1 (4) if the child was conceived as a result of a sexual assault as defined in article eight-B of
- 2 chapter sixty-one of this code.
- 3 (b) The State Registrar is permitted to charge a fee for the issuance of the certificate. The
- 4 fee shall be the same as the fee for a death certificate issued by the State Registrar.
- 5 (c) The certificate shall include, but is not limited to:
- 6 (1) Name of the stillborn child;
- 7 (2) Date of delivery;
- 8 (3) County of delivery;
- 9 (4) Mother's name and birthplace;
- 10 (5) Father's name and birthplace; and
- 11 (6) The statement: "This certificate is not proof of live birth."
- 12 (d) The certificate does not affect the registration, filing or record requirements of this article,
- 13 nor does the issuance of the certificate impose upon a coroner or medical examiner any additional
- 14 duties to conduct an investigation.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to create a certificate of birth resulting in stillbirth following the reporting of fetal death.

§16-5-20a is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
