13	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
14	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new
15	section, designated §3-9-14, to read as follows:
16	ARTICLE 9. OFFENSES AND PENALTIES.
17	§3-9-14. Absentee ballot fraud; intimidation of voters; penalties.
18	Any person who, with the intent to commit fraud, obtains, removes, completes or
19	disseminates an absentee ballot or intimidates an absentee voter, is guilty of a felony and, upon
20	conviction thereof, shall be fined not less than \$10,000 nor more than \$20,000 or imprisoned in a
21	state correctional facility not less than one nor more than five years, or both fined and imprisoned

For the purposes of this section, each ballot obtained is a separate offense.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide that absentee ballot fraud or intimidation of voters is a felony.
