Prohibiting certain changes to managed care. 17 Neither the department, or its Bureau of Medical Services shall apply for a federal waiver 18 necessary to gain federal approval to either add a new Medicaid benefit category or to add an 19 additional Medicaid eligibility group to the Medicaid managed care program without legislation 20 authorizing the submission of such waiver.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to prohibit the Department of Health and Human Resources from expanding the managed care population without authorization from the Legislature. This section is new; therefore, it is completely underscored.
