10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
11 relating to authorizing the Board of Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
12 licensure, disciplinary and complaint procedures; continuing education; and physician
13 assistants.

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

15 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and
16 reenacted to read as follows:

17 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**
18 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

19 **§64-9-1. Board of Medicine.**

20 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 22, 2014, authorized under the
21 authority of section three, article three-e, chapter thirty, of this code, modified by the Board of
22 Medicine to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in

1 the State Register on November 20, 2014, relating to the Board of Medicine (licensure, disciplinary
2 and complaint procedures; continuing education; and physician assistants, [11 CSR 1B](#)), is
3 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to licensure, disciplinary and complaint procedures; continuing education; and physician assistants.
