A BILL to amend and reenact article 6, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the State Police to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the regulations and procedures pertaining to the West Virginia DNA databank.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 6, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 6. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AFFAIRS AND PUBLIC SAFETY TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-6-1. State Police.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 25, 2014, authorized under the authority of section twenty-four, article two, chapter fifteen, of this code, modified by the State Police to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on December 30, 2014, relating to the State Police (regulations and procedures

1 pertaining to the West Virginia DNA databank, [81 CSR 9](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the State Police to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the regulations and procedures pertaining to the West Virginia DNA Databank.
