- 9 (a) Every teacher on July 1, 2015, shall receive an annual salary increase of \$1,000 per year.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to grant all public employees, all teachers, all service employees, all public employee retirees, all teacher retirees and all service employee retirees a \$1,000 per year permanent pay increase.

These sections are new; therefore, they have been completely underscored.
