- 1 (b) For the purposes of this section possession shall be broadly construed to include cased
- 2 weapons and the carrying of firearms by all persons with valid licenses to carry a concealed deadly
- 3 weapon pursuant to section four of this article.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to permit the possession of firearms on the grounds of higher education institutions by all persons with valid licenses to carry a concealed deadly weapon.
