16	§19-1C-5. Compensation of board members.	
17	(a) The ex officio members of the board may not receive compensation for serving on the	
18	board.	
19	(b) The appointed members of the board shall receive compensation for each day or portion	
20	of a day engaged in the discharge of official duties, which compensation may not exceed the amount	
21	paid to members of the Legislature for their interim duties as recommended by the Citizens	
22	Legislative Compensation Commission and authorized by law.	
23	(c) Each member of the board shall be reimbursed actual and necessary expenses incurred

- 1 for each day or portion of a day engaged in the discharge of official duties in a manner consistent
- 2 with the guidelines of the Travel Management Office of the Department of Administration West
- 3 Virginia Department of Agriculture Travel Policy and Procedure.
