10	A BILL to amend and reenact §19-29-4 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
11	to the inspection and slaughter of nontraditional agriculture; and removing the requirement
12	that all nontraditional agriculture needing to be slaughtered be slaughtered in an inspected
13	slaughterhouse.
14	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
15	That §19-29-4 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted
16	to read as follows:
17	ARTICLE 29. PRODUCTION OF NONTRADITIONAL AGRICULTURE PRODUCTS.
18	§19-29-4. Inspection of animals, meat and meat products.
19	The commissioner shall promulgate propose rules for legislative approval in accordance with
20	article three, chapter twenty-nine-a of this code, to include inspection of the meat from nontraditional
21	agriculture intended for sale in commercial outlets. All nontraditional agriculture needing to be
22	slaughtered shall be slaughtered in an inspected slaughterhouse.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to remove the requirement that all nontraditional agriculture needing to be slaughtered be slaughtered in an inspected slaughterhouse.
