13	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
14	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new
15	section, designated §46A-6-109a, to read as follows:
16	ARTICLE 6. GENERAL CONSUMER PROTECTION.
17	§46A-6-109a. Failure to provide written contract not unfair or deceptive act.
18	Notwithstanding any other provision of this code to the contrary and notwithstanding the
19	provisions of Attorney General rule §142-5-3, it is not an unfair or deceptive practice to have an oral
20	contract to perform any home improvement transaction. The Attorney General shall amend its rules
21	to comply with this section.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to allow an oral contract to be used to perform any home improvement transaction.
