Senate Bill No. 154
(By Senator Snyder)

[Introduced January 14, 2015; referred to the Committee on Labor; and then to the Committee on
the Judiciary.]

A BILL to amend and reenact article 10, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
relating to authorizing the Division of Labor to promulgate a legislative rule relating to child
labor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 10, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and
reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 10. AUTHORIZATION FOR BUREAU OF COMMERCE TO PROMULGATE
LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-10-1. Division of Labor.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 30, 2014, authorized under the
authority of section eleven, article six, chapter twenty-one of this code, modified by the Division of
Labor to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the
State Register on December 2, 2014, relating to the Division of Labor (child labor, [42 CSR 9](#)), is

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Division of Labor to promulgate a legislative rule relating to child labor.
