10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,

11                   relating to authorizing the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to

12                   immunizations administered by pharmacists.

13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

14                   That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and

15 reenacted to read as follows:

16 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**

17 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

18 **§64-9-1. Board of Pharmacy.**

19                   The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 1, 2014, authorized under the

20 authority of section seven, article five, chapter thirty, of this code, modified by the Board of

21 Pharmacy to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in

1 the State Register on January 8, 2015, relating to the Board of Pharmacy (immunizations  
2 administered by pharmacists, [15 CSR 12](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Immunizations Administered by Pharmacists.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
