Senate Bill No. 213
(By Senator Snyder)

[Introduced January 14, 2015; referred to the Committee on Agriculture and Rural Development;
and then to the Committee on the Judiciary.]

A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
relating to authorizing the Commissioner of Agriculture to promulgate a legislative rule
relating to the fee structure for the Pesticide Control Act of 1990.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and
reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Commissioner of Agriculture.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 29, 2014, authorized under the
authority of section four, article sixteen-a, chapter nineteen of this code, modified by the
Commissioner of Agriculture to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review

- 1 Committee and refiled in the State Register on October 30, 2014, relating to the Commissioner of
- 2 Agriculture (fee structure for the Pesticide Control Act of 1990, 61 CSR 12), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Commissioner of Agriculture to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the Fee Structure for the Pesticide Control Act of 1990.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
