4 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
5 designated §18-10G-5a, relating to creating the Rehabilitation Services Vending Program
6 Fund.

9 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

10 That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new
11 section, designated §18-10G-5a, to read as follows:

12 **ARTICLE 10G. PROVIDING OF FOOD SERVICE IN PUBLIC OFFICE BUILDINGS BY**
13 **THE WEST VIRGINIA DIVISION OF VOCATIONAL**
14 **REHABILITATION.**

15 **§18-10G-5a. Rehabilitation Services Vending Program Fund created.**

16 There is created in the State Treasury a special revenue fund to be known as the
17 "Rehabilitation Services Vending Program Fund." The fund shall operate as a special revenue fund
18 whereby all deposits and payments thereto do not expire to the General Revenue Fund, but shall
19 remain in the fund and be available for expenditure in succeeding fiscal years. This fund consists

1 of moneys deposited in the fund pursuant to the provisions of section five of this article. Money
2 from this fund shall be expended by the Director of the Division of Rehabilitation Services pursuant
3 to the provisions of section five of this article.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to create the Rehabilitation Services Vending Program
Fund.
