9 A BILL making a supplementary appropriation from the State Fund, State Excess Lottery Revenue  
10 Fund, to the Division of Human Services, fund 5365, fiscal year 2015, organization 0511,  
11 by supplementing and amending the appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015.  
12 Whereas, The Governor submitted to the Legislature, a Statement of the State Excess Lottery  
13 Revenue Fund, dated January 14, 2015, setting forth therein the cash balance as of July 1, 2014, and  
14 further included the estimate of revenue for the fiscal year 2015, less regular appropriations for the  
15 fiscal year 2015; and

16 Whereas, It appears from the Governor’s Statement of the State Excess Lottery Revenue  
17 Fund, there now remains an unappropriated balance in the State Treasury which is available for  
18 appropriation during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015; therefore

19 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

20 That the total appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, to fund 5365, fiscal year  
21 2015, organization 0511, be supplemented and amended to by increasing an existing item of
