Food handler examinations and cards. 19 All food handlers are required to pass an examination from an accredited food safety 20 certification program, with at least one online accredited food safety certification program offered. 21 The bureau shall approve a list of accredited food safety certification programs. Once the 22 examination is passed, the food handler shall be issued a card that is valid for three years. A food

- 1 handler card is required within thirty days of being hired in a restaurant or other applicable food
- 2 establishment and is valid in every county of the state.
