AN ACT to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated §61-2-9d, relating to crimes against the person; providing that strangling is a criminal offense; defining bodily injury and strangling; providing a felony offense of strangling another; and providing criminal penalties.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated §61-2-9d, to read as follows:

§61-2-9d. Strangulation; definitions; penalties.

- 1 (a) As used in this section:
- 2 (1) "Bodily injury" means substantial physical pain, illness
- 3 or any impairment of physical condition;
- 4 (2) "Strangle" means knowingly and willfully restricting
- 5 another person's air intake or blood flow by the application of
- 6 pressure on the neck or throat;
- 7 (b) Any person who strangles another and thereby causes
- 8 them bodily injury or thereby to lose consciousness is guilty of
- 9 a felony and upon conviction thereof shall be confined in a state
- 10 correctional facility for not less than one year or more than five
- 11 years fined not more than \$2,500.00, or both.
