A BILL to amend and reenact §5F-2-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended; and to amend said code by adding thereto twelve new sections, designated §5F-2-1a, §5F-2-1b, §5F-2-1c, §5F-2-1d, §5F-2-1e, §5F-2-1f, §5F-2-1g, §5F-2-1h, §5F-2-1i, §5F-2-1j, §5F-2-1k and §5F-2-1l, all relating to the reorganization of certain code provisions that organize the executive branch of state government.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §5F-2-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted; and that said code be amended by adding

thereto twelve new sections, designated §5F-2-1a, §5F-2-1b, §5F-2-1c, §5F-2-1d, §5F-2-1e, §5F-2-1f, §5F-2-1g, §5F-2-1h, §5F-2-1i, §5F-2-1j, §5F-2-1k and §5F-2-1l, all to read as follows:

210 (a) The Legislature finds that in 1989, this chapter was
211 enacted to provide for the reorganization of the executive branch

212 of state government pursuant to the findings set forth under
213 section one, article one of this chapter. This section was enacted
214 as part of that legislation to effect the transfer of agencies and
215 board and related entities into the various departments created
216 within the executive branch of government. Since its initial
217 enactment, the Legislature has amended and reenacted this
218 section on a number of occasions, in most instances to modify
219 the initial reorganization within the executive branch of
220 government. The Legislature further finds that the structure of
221 this section by which it provides an extensive list of executive
222 agencies in a single section of the Code of West Virginia renders
223 this section unnecessarily lengthy and complicated. The
224 designation of a separate statute for each of the agencies and
225 entities as they are organized in subsections (a) through (l) of
226 this section as provided pursuant to the amendment and
227 reenactment of this section in 2015 would reduce the
228 unnecessary length and complexity of the statute without altering
229 the Legislature's intent in providing for the organization of the
230 executive branch of state government pursuant to the original
231 findings set forth under section one, article one of this chapter

232 and the Legislature's subsequent amendments and reenactments
233 of various sections of this chapter. The Legislature therefore
234 finds and declares that the amendment and reenactment of this
235 section and the further amendment of the Code of West Virginia
236 by adding thereto twelve new sections, designated sections one-
237 a, one-b, one-c, one-d, one-e, one-f, one-g, one-h, one-i, one-j,
238 one-k, and one-l of this article, are solely for the purpose of
239 designating a separate statute for each of the agencies and
240 entities as they are organized in subsections (a) through (l) of
241 this section as provided pursuant to the amendment and
242 reenactment of this section in 2015 and for the purpose of
243 providing corrective descriptions of an agency and corrective
244 code references and deleting references to agencies, boards or
245 commissions that have been repealed. The Legislature further
246 finds and declares that except as otherwise provided in this
247 section, the amendment and reenactment of this section and the
248 enactment of the new sections may not be construed to have
249 altered or modified the application of any other provision of this
250 code to the agencies and entities described in those sections, and
251 that all other provisions of this code, to the extent applicable to

252 those sections, as well as the remaining subsections of this
253 section, shall apply in like manner to the agencies and entities
254 described in those new sections.

255 (Ⓜ) (b) Except for powers, authority and duties that have
256 been delegated to the secretaries of the departments by the
257 provisions of section two of this article, the position of
258 administrator and the powers, authority and duties of each
259 administrator and agency are not affected by the enactment of
260 this chapter.

261 (Ⓝ) (c) Except for powers, authority and duties that have
262 been delegated to the secretaries of the departments by the
263 provisions of section two of this article, the existence, powers,
264 authority and duties of boards and the membership, terms and
265 qualifications of members of the boards are not affected by the
266 enactment of this chapter. All boards that are appellate bodies or
267 are independent decision makers shall not have their appellate or
268 independent decision-making status affected by the enactment of
269 this chapter.
