A BILL to amend and reenact §5F-2-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended; and to amend said code by adding thereto twelve new sections, designated §5F-2-1a, §5F-2-1b, §5F-2-1c, §5F-2-1d, §5F-2-1e, §5F-2-1f, §5F-2-1g, §5F-2-1h, §5F-2-1i, §5F-2-1j, §5F-2-1k and §5F-2-1l, all relating to the reorganization of certain code provisions that organize the executive branch of state government.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §5F-2-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted; and that said code be amended by adding

enacted to provide for the reorganization of the executive branch

212 of state government pursuant to the findings set forth under 213 section one, article one of this chapter. This section was enacted 214 as part of that legislation to effect the transfer of agencies and 215 board and related entities into the various departments created 216 within the executive branch of government. Since its initial 217 enactment, the Legislature has amended and reenacted this 218 section on a number of occasions, in most instances to modify 219 the initial reorganization within the executive branch of 220 government. The Legislature further finds that the structure of 221 this section by which it provides an extensive list of executive 222 agencies in a single section of the Code of West Virginia renders 223 this section unnecessarily lengthy and complicated. The 224 designation of a separate statute for each of the agencies and 225 entities as they are organized in subsections (a) through (l) of 226 this subsection as provided pursuant to the amendment and 227 reenactment of this section in 2011 would reduce the 228 unnecessary length and complexity of the statute without altering 229 the Legislature's intent in providing for the organization of the 230 executive branch of state government pursuant to the original 231 findings set forth under section one, article one of this chapter

232 and the Legislature's subsequent amendments and reenactments 233 of various sections of this chapter. The Legislature therefore 234 finds and declares that the amendment and reenactment of this 235 section and the further amendment of the Code of West Virginia 236 by adding thereto twelve new sections, designated section one-a, 237 article two, chapter five-f, section one-b, article two, chapter 238 five-f, section one-c, article two, chapter five-f, section one-d, 239 article two, chapter five-f, section one-e, article two, chapter 240 five-f, section one-f, article two, chapter five-f, section one-g, 241 article two, chapter five-f, section one-h, article two, chapter 242 five-f, section one-i, article two, chapter five-f, section one-i, 243 article two, chapter five-f, section one-k, article two, chapter 244 five-f and section one-l, article two, chapter five-f. These new 245 sections are solely for purpose of designating a separate statute 246 for each of the agencies and entities as they are organized in 247 subsections (a) through (l) of this subsection as provided 248 pursuant to the amendment and reenactment of this section in 249 2011, and in section one-k, article two, chapter five-f, to provide 250 for corrective descriptions of an agency and to add an additional 251 agency to the list of agencies organized under that section. 252 Legislature further finds and declares that except as otherwise 253 provided in this section, the amendment and reenactment of this section and the enactment of the new sections may not be 254 255 construed to have altered or modified the application of any 256 other provision of this code to the agencies and entities described 257 in those sections, and that all other provisions of this code, to the 258 extent applicable to those subsections, as well as the remaining 259 subsections of this section, shall to apply in like manner to the 260 agencies and entities described in those new sections. 261 (m) (b) Except for powers, authority and duties that have 262 been delegated to the secretaries of the departments by the 263 provisions of section two of this article, the position of 264 administrator and the powers, authority and duties of each 265 administrator and agency are not affected by the enactment of 266 this chapter. 267 (n) (c) Except for powers, authority and duties that have 268 been delegated to the secretaries of the departments by the 269 provisions of section two of this article, the existence, powers, 270 authority and duties of boards and the membership, terms and
