Introduced S.B. 282 2016R1275

1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,

designated §5A-1-10, relating to collection of a fee from certain special revenue accounts.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

- That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new
- 2 section, designated §5A-1-10, to read as follow:

### ARTICLE 1. DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION.

### §5A-1-10. Collection of fees from special revenue accounts; disposition of funds.

- The secretary shall assess and collect annually a five percent administrative fee from each
- 2 special revenue account which does not receive federal funds or pension funds, and shall deposit
- 3 money from the fees into the General Revenue Fund.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require the Secretary of Administration to assess and collect a fee of five percent annually from certain special revenue funds and to deposit the funds into the General Revenue Fund.
