- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,  
2 designated §5A-1-10, relating to collection of a fee from certain special revenue accounts.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

- 1 That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new  
2 section, designated §5A-1-10, to read as follow:

**ARTICLE 1. DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION.**

**§5A-1-10. Collection of fees from special revenue accounts; disposition of funds.**

- 1 The secretary shall assess and collect annually a five percent administrative fee from each  
2 special revenue account which does not receive federal funds or pension funds, and shall deposit  
3 money from the fees into the General Revenue Fund.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require the Secretary of Administration to assess and collect a fee of five percent annually from certain special revenue funds and to deposit the funds into the General Revenue Fund.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
