1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,

designated §24-6-6c, relating to additional dedicated fee for 911.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

1 That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new

section, designated §24-6-6c, to read as follows:

### ARTICLE 6. LOCAL EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM.

### §24-6-6c. Authorization of Additional Local 911 fees.

- 1 (a) Effective July 1, 2016, any county commission may authorize the collection of an
- 2 additional enhanced county 911 fee not to exceed \$1 per month per wireless subscriber which
- 3 resides in that county. Such fees shall be in addition to fees outlined in section six (b) of this
- 4 article, however the additional fees assessed herein shall be collected by the Public Service
- 5 Commission in the same manner as provided in this article for other fees and returned specifically
- 6 to the county which authorized the additional fee.
- 7 (b) All additional funds received pursuant to this section shall be restricted in use,
- 8 specifically dedicated to the operation, maintenance and personnel costs associated with the
- 9 operational needs of the county 911 center of the county authorizing and generating such
- 10 additional fees.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize county commissions to authorize the collection of additional fee, not to exceed \$1 per subscriber of wireless phone lines.
