1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,

designated §61-2-8a, relating to making it illegal to transport a minor across state lines to

obtain an abortion without written consent of both parents or legal guardians; and

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

1 That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new

section, designated §61-2-8a, to read as follows:

### ARTICLE 2. CRIMES AGAINST THE PERSON.

### §61-2-8a. Transporting a minor across state lines for an abortion; penalty.

A person who transports a minor across state lines to obtain an abortion, without the

written consent of both parents or the legal guardians of the minor, is guilty of a

3 misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be fined not less than \$500 nor more than \$1,000, or

4 confined in jail not more than six months, or both fined and confined.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to make it a misdemeanor to transport a minor across state lines to obtain an abortion without written consent by both parents or her legal guardians.

This section is new; therefore, it has been completely underscored.
