- A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section.
   designated §9-2-13, relating generally to benefits provided by the Department of Human
   Services; requiring benefit access devices to have a photograph of the person to whom a
   device was issued; permitting a benefit access device to be used by another authorized
   individual on the device holder's behalf; defining terms; and providing for rule-making.
   *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*
- 6 That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new
  7 section, designated §9-2-13, to read as follows:

## ARTICLE 2. COMMISSIONER OF HUMAN SERVICES; POWERS, DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES GENERALLY.

#### §9-2-13. Benefit access device; photograph; who may use; definitions; rule-making.

- 8 (a) For the purposes of this section:
- 9 "Benefits" means any payment, allotments, money, goods or other things of value granted
- 10 pursuant to a benefit program.
- 11 "Benefit access device" means any card, plate, account number or other means of access
- 12 that can be used, alone or in conjunction with another access device, to obtain payments,
- 13 allotments, benefits, money, goods or other things of value that can be used to initiate a transfer
- 14 <u>of funds.</u>
- 15 "Benefit program" includes the Federal Food Stamp Act, Supplemental Nutritional

16 Assistance Program, Temporary Assistance to Needy Families, other similar state or federal

- 17 <u>financial assistance program or other program sponsored by the department.</u>
- 18 (b) All benefit access devices that permit access to benefits or a benefit program shall
- 19 have a photograph of the person to whom the device was issued.
- 20 (c) A benefit access device may also be used by another authorized individual, such as a

- 21 caregiver, who may, with proper photo identification, to use the device for the device holder's
- 22 <u>benefit.</u>
- 23 (d) The secretary shall propose rules in accordance with article three, chapter twenty-nine-
- 24 a of this code that are necessary to effectuate the requirements and purposes of this section by
- 25 <u>September 30, 2015.</u>

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require benefit access devices to have a photograph of the person to whom a device was issued. The bill permits a benefit access device to be used by another authorized individual on the device holder's behalf. The bill defining terms provides for rule-making.

This section is new; therefore, it has been completely underscored.
