# House Bill 4086

- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, Chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as
- 2 amended, relating to authorizing the Department of Agriculture to promulgate a legislative
- 3 rule relating to captive cervid farming.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

- That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended
- 5 and reenacted to read as follows:

# ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-9-1. Department of Agriculture.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 28, 2015, authorized under the
- 2 authority of section twelve, article two-h, chapter nineteen, of this code, modified by the
- 3 Department of Agriculture to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review
- 4 Committee and refiled in the State Register on November 5, 2015, relating to the Department of
- 5 Agriculture (captive cervid farming, 61 CSR 34), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Agriculture to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Captive Cervid Farming.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
