- A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as
  amended, relating to authorizing the Board of Dental Examiners to promulgate a legislative
- 3 rule relating to expanded duties of dental hygienists and dental assistants.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

- 1 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended
- 2 and reenacted to read as follows:

### ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-9-1. Board of Dental Examiners.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 23, 2015, authorized under the authority of section six, article four, chapter thirty, of this code, modified by the Board of Dental Examiners to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on September 23, 2015, relating to the Board of Dental Examiners (expanded duties of dental hygienists and dental assistants, 5 <u>CSR</u> 13), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Dental Examiners to promulgate a legislative rule relating to expanded duties of dental hygienists and dental assistants.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
