A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as
 amended, relating to authorizing the State Board of Registration for Professional
 Engineers to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the examination, licensure and
 practice of professional engineers.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended
and reenacted to read as follows:

### 3 ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS

#### 4 TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64–9–1. State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on May 11, 2015, authorized under the authority of section nine, article thirteen, chapter thirty, of this code, modified by the State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on September 22, 2015, relating to the State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers (examination, licensure and practice of professional engineers, 7 CSR 1), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the Examination, Licensure and Practice of Professional Engineers.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
