Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

- 1 That article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended
- 2 and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-5-1. Department of Health and Human Resources.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 27, 2015, authorized under the authority of section four, article thirty-five, chapter nineteen, of this code, modified by the Department of Health and Human Resources to meet the objections of the Legislative Rulemaking Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on October 23, 2015, relating to the Department of Health and Human Resources (farmers market vendors, 64 CSR 102), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Farmers Market Vendors.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
