- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as
- amended, relating to authorizing the Department of Health and Human Resources to
- 3 promulgate a legislative rule relating to neonatal abstinence centers.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-5-1. Department of Health and Human Resources.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 31, 2015, authorized under the
- 2 authority of section four, article one, chapter sixteen, of this code, modified by the Department of
- 3 Health and Human Resources to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review
- 4 Committee and refiled in the State Register on December 8, 2015, relating to the Department of
- 5 Health and Human Resources (neonatal abstinence centers, 69 CSR 9), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Neonatal Abstinence Centers.
