1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new a section,

designated §24-2-11, relating to prohibiting fuel surcharges in certain instances; and

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

1 That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new

2 section, designated §24-2-1I, to read as follows

ARTICLE 2. POWERS AND DUTIES OF PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION.

§24-2-11. Fuel surcharges; rule-making.

- 1 (a) Notwithstanding any provision of this code to the contrary, no surcharge relating to fuel
- 2 costs, or the cost of fuel, may remain in effect, be charged or collected by a public utility or other
- 3 entity under the jurisdiction of the Public Service Commission when those fuel costs that
- 4 precipitated the surcharge decrease by twenty-five per cent or more.
- 5 (b) The commission shall promulgate rules pursuant to article three, chapter twenty-nine-
- 6 a of this code to implement this section.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to prohibit fuel surcharges in certain instances. The bill provides for rule-making.
