### **House Bill 4420**

1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,  
 2 designated §16-9A-6, relating to electronic cigarettes and vapor products; requiring the  
 3 listing of the ingredients contained in the products; and prohibiting the sale of unlabeled  
 4 vapor products.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

1 That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new  
 2 section, designated §16-9A-6, to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 9A. TOBACCO USAGE RESTRICTIONS.**

**§16-9A-6. Required labeling of vapor products.**

1 All vapor products, whether or not that product contains nicotine, offered for sale in this  
 2 state must be labeled with a list of the ingredients, arranged by weight in descending order,  
 3 contained in the portion of the product that is consumed, vaporized or released during the use of  
 4 the product. No person or business entity may sell or offer for sale any unpackaged vapor product  
 5 that does not bear this label.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require the listing of the ingredients contained in vapor products; and prohibit the sale of unlabeled vapor products.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
