INTRODUCED H.B. 2016R2600

1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,

designated §24A-2-7, relating to exempting taxicab companies whose drivers are

independent contractors, from providing workers' compensation coverage for the drivers.

### ARTICLE 2. COMMON CARRIERS BY MOTOR VEHICLES.

#### §24A-2-7. Workers' compensation coverage.

1 <u>A taxicab company operating under this chapter is not required to provide workers'</u>

compensation coverage to a driver who provides taxicab service pursuant to a written or electronic

agreement that identifies the taxicab driver as an independent contractor.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to exempt taxicab companies, whose drivers are independent contractors, from providing workers' compensation coverage for the drivers.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
