1 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as
 2 amended, relating to authorizing the Governor’s Committee on Crime, Delinquency and
 3 Correction to promulgate a legislative rule relating to law-enforcement training and
 4 certification standards.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

1 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended
 2 and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS
 TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64–9–9. Governor’s Committee on Crime, Delinquency and Correction .

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 27, 2015, authorized under the
 2 authority of section three, article twenty-nine, chapter thirty, of this code, modified by the
 3 Governor’s Committee on Crime, Delinquency and Correction to meet the objections of the
 4 Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on November 5,
 5 2015, relating to the Governor’s Committee on Crime, Delinquency and Correction (law
 6 enforcement training and certification standards, 149 CSR 2), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Governor’s Committee on Crime, Delinquency and Correction to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Law Enforcement Training and Certification Standards.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
