	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
1	That §30-14-12 of the Code of West Virginia 1931, as amended, be amended and
2	reenacted to read as follows:
	ARTICLE 14. OSTEOPATHIC PHYSICIANS AND SURGEONS.
	§30-14-12. Offenses; penalties.
1	(a) Each of the following acts shall constitute a misdemeanor, punishable upon conviction
2	by a fine of not less than one thousand nor more than \$10,000:
3	(a) The practice or attempting to practice as an osteopathic physician and surgeon without
4	a license or permit;
5	(b) (1) The obtaining of or an attempt to obtain a license or permit to practice in the
6	profession for money or any other thing of value, by fraudulent misrepresentation;
7	(c) (2) The making of any willfully false oath or affirmation whenever an oath or affirmation
8	is required by this article; and
9	(d) (3) Advertising, practicing or attempting to practice under a name other than one's own.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to align the criminal penalties of practicing osteopathic medicine with those of practicing allopathic medicine.
