### **House Bill 2119**

1 A BILL to repeal §33-16G-1, §33-16G-2, §33-16G-3, §33-16G-4, §33-16G-5, §33-16G-6, §33-  
2 16G-7, §33-16G-8, and §33-16G-9 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended; all  
3 relating to repealing the West Virginia Health Benefit Exchange Act.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

1 **§1. Repeal of article creating the West Virginia Health Benefit Exchange Act.**

2 That §33-16G-1, §33-16G-2, §33-16G-3, §33-16G-4, §33-16G-5, §33-16G-6, §33-16G-7,  
3 §33-16G-8, and §33-16G-9 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, are hereby repealed.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to repeal the West Virginia Health Benefit Exchange Act.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
