1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1, of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
 2 to authorizing the Board of Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Licensure,
 3 Disciplinary and Complaint Procedures, Continuing Education, Physician Assistants.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

1 That §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted
 2 to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS
 TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Board of Medicine.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 12, 2016, authorized under the
 2 authority of section three, article three-e, chapter thirty of this code, modified by the Board of
 3 Medicine to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in
 4 the State Register on September 1, 2016, relating to the Board of Medicine (Licensure,
 5 Disciplinary and Complaint Procedures, Continuing Education, Physician Assistants, 11 CSR 1B),
 6 is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Licensure, Disciplinary and Complaint Procedures, Continuing Education, Physician Assistants.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
