1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
 2 to authorizing the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule, relating to a
 3 Controlled Substances Monitoring Program.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

1 That §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted
 2 to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS
 TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Board of Pharmacy.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 18, 2016, authorized under the
 2 authority of section six, article nine, chapter sixty-a of this code, modified by the Board of
 3 Pharmacy to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in
 4 the State Register on December 19, 2016, relating to the Board of Pharmacy (Controlled
 5 Substances Monitoring Program, [15 CSR 08](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to a Controlled Substances Monitoring Program.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
