1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
 2 to authorizing the Public Service Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
 3 Telephone Conduit Occupancy.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

1 That §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted
 2 to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS
 TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Public Service Commission.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 26, 2016, authorized under the
 2 authority of section three, article two-e, chapter twenty-four of this code, modified by the Public
 3 Service Commission to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee
 4 and refiled in the State Register on December 13, 2016, relating to the Public Service Commission
 5 (Telephone Conduit Occupancy, [150 CSR 37](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Public Service Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Telephone Conduit Occupancy.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
